Recipe Corner

1/2 cup butter 30 large marshmallows $1 \frac{1}{2}$ tsp. green food coloring 1 tsp. vanilla extract 4 cups cornflakes cereal 2 Tbsp. cinnamon red hot candies

Christmas Wreath Cookies

Set out one or two sheets of waxed paper. Melt butter in a large saucepan over low heat. Add marshmallows, and cook stirring constantly, until melted. Remove from the heat, stir in food coloring and vanilla, then stir in cornflakes. Fill a skillet with 1" of very hot water. Place the saucepan into the skillet so cookie dough stays warm. Quickly drop a heaping tablespoonful of cookie dough onto the waxed paper, and use lightly greased fingers to form it into a wreath shape. Immediately decorate cookie with red hot candies. Repeat to shape and decorate remaining cookies. Allow cookies to cool to room temperature before removing from waxed paper, about 15 minutes. Store in an airtight container.

Cream Cheese Christmas Cookies

Cream together the butter and cream cheese. Add sugar and vanilla: beat until light and fluffy. Combine the flour and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture, beating until well blended. Stir in chopped pecans. Cover bowl with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 15 minutes. On four sheets of aluminum foil, shape dough into four 6" rolls, 1 1/2" in diameter. Wrap each roll tightly in foil and refrigerate over night. Preheat oven to 325°. Line cookie sheets with foil. Remove rolls of dough from refrigerator one at a time. Coat each roll with red or green sugar crystals; cut dough into 1/4" slices. Place on prepared cookie sheets; top each cookie with a pecan half. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until bottom of cookie is lightly browned when lifted.

ever wondered why your brain decides mv four-vear tour at Fort Wainwright in Fairbanks, Alaska. For some reason, I remember us sitting down together on Monday evenings and both of us furry, wise-cracking alien life form who crashed to Earth and lived with the Tanner family, was on TV. 
