



Fishing Net - From my experience, signed for and still used for attaching more big fish are lost at the boat or on the bank than at any other point after risers, this small diameter nylon line hooking up. Having a good net present has a 550-lb. tensile strength, hence its helps significantly increase the odds of name. It comes in a myriad of colors and catching a good fish. I have three different size nets from a small wooden one for trout to a massive one for catfish. 11. 21 oz. can cherry

fruit pie filling

16 oz. can whole berry cranberry sauce 1/4 tsp. cinnamon 12 oz. can Pillsbury refrigerated Buttermilk Biscuits 1/2 C. powdered sugar 2 tsp. milk 1/4 tsp. almond extract 2 Tbsp. sliced almonds

Heat oven to 400°. In medium saucepan, combine pie filling, cranberry sauce and cinnamon. 2 1/2 lb. Country ribs 3 Tbsp. flour 1/2 tsp. garlic salt 2 Tbsp. butter 4 med. potatoes, pared and sliced 1 can cream style corn 1/2 tsp. salt 1/4 tsp. black pepper 1/4 C. chopped onions 1/4 C. chopped green

peppers

3/4 C. milk

Dust ribs with flour and garlic salt. Brown in butter. Cook until tender (about 40 minutes). Layer potatoes in greased baking dish. Sprinkle with salt, black pepper, onion, and green peppers. Pour milk over vegetables. Cover with corn; top with brown ribs, covering vegetables, in a single layer. Cover and bake at 350° for 30 minutes. Remove cover and bake for 20 minutes longer or until potatoes are tender.

STUFFED CABBAGE **ROLLS**

1 cabbage

1 lb. ground beef, cooked 1/2 lb. ground pork, cooked 3 C. cooked rice 1 tsp. sugar 1 lb. bacon (uncooked) 1 onion, chopped 1 tsp. salt 1/4 tsp. butter 1 C. hot water $10 \, 1/2$ oz. can cream of tomato soup

Combine beef, pork, rice, sugar, onion, salt, and pepper. Wilt cabbage leaves by placing in boiling water for 2 to 3 minutes. Place about 1/2 C. of mixture on each cabbage leaf and roll securely. Place half of bacon on bottom of baking dish. Set rolls on top of bacon and place the 1 C. peanut butter remaining bacon over rolls. Combine water and soup and pour over rolls. 1/2 C. shelled peanuts powdered sugar, milk Bake at 350° for 1 hour. 1/2 C. raisins Serves 6.

UPSIDE DOWN HAM LOAF 1 1/4 lb. ground,

smoked ham 1/2 lb. ground pork 1/4 C. minced onion 1 C. dry bread crumbs 1 C. milk 1/2 tsp. salt 1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce 1 tsp. mustard 1 egg 1/4 C. brown sugar, firmly packed 1/2 C. crushed pineapple, drained 1 Tbsp. vinegar

Combine ham, pork, onion, bread crumbs, milk, Worcestershire and mustard, sauce, blending well. Mix egg, brown sugar, pineapple, and vinegar and pour into a loaf pan, spreading evenly and into corners. Pack loaf mixture carefully, but firmly, on top of pineapple mixture. Bake at 350° for 1 1/4 hours. Let stand for 10 minutes; drain juice and turn onto a platter. Serves 6.

3 lb. chicken wings 1/2 C. flour 1 egg, beaten 1/2 C. Butter SAUCE: 3 Tbsp. soy sauce 1 C. sugar 1 tsp. Accent seasoning 3 Tbsp. water 1/2 C. vinegar 1/2 tsp. salt

CHOCOLATE PEANUT BUTTER **GRAHAMS**

18 oz. jar peanut butter 16 oz. pkg. graham crackers, broken into rectangles

1 1/2 lbs. milk chocolate candy coating

Spread a rounded teaspoonful of peanut butter on one side of half of the graham crackers. Top with remaining crackers. In heavy saucepan over low heat, melt candy coating; stir until smooth. Dip cookies in coating to completely cover; allow excess to drip off. Place on waxed paper-lined baking sheets: let stand until firm. Store in airtight container in a cool, dry place. Optional: You can use round crackers instead of graham crackers.

- 1 C. (8 oz.) nonfat sour cream
- 1 carton (12 oz.) light frozen whipped topping, thawed

In a microwave-safe bowl, heat chocolate chips and milk at 50% power until chocolate is melted. Stir in vanilla. Chill for 2 hours or until mixture is easy to handle. Shape into 1" balls. Roll in coconut, sprinkles, cocoa or nuts if desired. Yield: about 4 dozen.

Cover and bake at 425° for 30 minutes or until the potatoes are tender. Sprinkle with cheese and parsley. Bake, uncovered 5 minutes longer or until cheese is melted. Yield: 4 servings.

FLAVORFUL MEAT LOAF

1 medium carrot, shredded 1/4 C. chopped onion 2 Tbsp. soy sauce 1 tsp. tomato paste 2 garlic cloves, minced 1/4 tsp. ground ginger 1/8 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes Pepper to taste 1/2 lb. ground beef 1/2 lb. ground pork

In a bowl, combine the first eight ingredients. Add beef and pork; mix well. Shape into a loaf in an ungreased shallow baking pan. Bake at 350° for 45-50 minutes or until meat is no longer pink and a meat thermometer reads 160°-170°; drain. Let stand for 10 minutes before slicing. Yield: 4 servings.
