





Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

Completely New Observations and Experiences Seem to Be in Store for 2024!

back on March 1,

2013, on my very first day as a military retiree after 31.5-years in uniform, my inaugural "Outdoor Opportunities" column appeared right here in the pages of the Weekly Bargain Bulletin. Over that time frame, I've had a lot of interesting, amazing, and amusing experiences occur, which I've had the privilege of sharing with readers. The ever-present possibility of seeing, hearing, or experiencing something completely new outdoors always drives me to get out-of-bed, out-of-the house, and into the woods or on the water as much as possible. If first time experiences in January and February 2024 are any indication of how 2024 is going to go, then I'm really excited about what may lie in store! Allow me to share what unusual has already happened so far.

Predator Prey relationships are important links in nature's food webs, but are sometimes difficult to get our minds wrapped around. We tend to anthropomorphize the predator as a villain and the prey as the victim. Occasionally, we get to see that interaction play out. Back on Jan. 4, 2024, I was up in Crawford County flintlock hunting with fellow outdoor writer, Jerry Bush. He was cautiously driving as we made our way up a pot-hole infested dirt road through intermittent fields and woodlots. Suddenly, going up a hill a small doe ran across the road about 200-yards ahead of us. She was followed by two smaller than average (for the time of year) fawns, which she must have had late in the Summer. Right on the heels of the second fleeing fawn was a pursuing coyote. Now, I've seen coyotes chasing deer before, but what came next was completely new. About the time the sprinting coyote got to the left side of road, an extremely large doe (she was almost twice the size of the first doe and 3X larger than the fawns) came barreling out from the right in hot pursuit of the covote. Frequently, whitetail does will travel in multi-generational family groups. I truly believe grandma doe was desperately trying her best to save her grandchildren from the coyote. Mature does will aggressively repel covotes with flailing sharp hooves. The chase was out-of-sight when we got to where they crossed, but I'll always wonder about the outcome.

Wow! It's hard deer trail. About first shooting light, to believe it was which is 30-minutes before sunrise, I 11-years ago today, started to hear a wild turkey gobbler gobbling from a wooded ridge about 300-yards south of my concealed hiding spot. Shortly thereafter, a second gobbler got fired up and responded with challenging gobbles at a little closer distance to the southeast. Now, I've heard gobblers gobbling in all months of the year, but when I heard a hen aggressively yelping back to "the boys", it was definitely a first in January for me. Hopefully, our warmer than usual Winter doesn't cause some turkeys to breed too early and then reoccurring cold Spring weather/rains kills poults.

I do know the 60-degree weather on Feb. 9 & 10 messed up one 30-inch garter snake. I was coyote hunting the morning of Sat., Feb 10 when I came across a garter snake about 2/3's of the way out of his hole in a state of 'suspended animation". Being coldblooded, I'm guessing the exceptionally warm temperature on Feb. 9 caused him to wake up and start to crawl outside, before the cold night temperature (back down around 36-degrees) caused his cold-blooded body to just shut down. When I first gently touched his side with my gloved finger, I detected a slight movement from some of his scales. Two or three light strokes got him retreating backward in extremely slow motion. Eventually, after 2-minutes, he was completely back in his hole. I reminded him to remain underground until Spring actually arrived.

Deer don't mind getting their feet wet. It's one reason you often hear about big bucks being taken out of swamps. I had a two-person ladder stand set up in a swamp by the Shenango River this past deer season. I tried to retrieve it on Mon., Jan. 27, but the recent rains had the Shenango above its banks and my ladder stand in 4-feet of water. So. my son went with me on the afternoon of Feb. 10 to remove the stand after the water receded. It was all good until we got within 5-yards of the tree my stand leaned against. The beavers had built a small dam on an outlet stream draining the swamp. Fortunately, it was still 52-degrees when I rolled my BDU pants up above my knees to wade into calf-deep water to retrieve the stand. The only good thing was my son had left his cell phone at the house and wasn't able to capture my entire ungraceful retrieval on video for poster-On Sat., Jan. 27, I was hunting down ity. There you have it. New things are in Allegheny County on the last day of constantly occurring outdoors. So, get the extended late archery season in out there in 2024 and experience them WMU 2B.
