

## **Outdoor Opportunities** By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II The Truth About Military Surplus Gear

It's

on a tangent after you've had a particular thought. When I finished typing last week's column about Rucking and men-MOLLE rucksack, my mind immediately went into overdrive regarding the amount of military surplus gear I've accumulated over the years for use during my many outdoor excursions. Now, a pen and paper readily available, so I just started jotting down a rudimentary list of some of the military items I count amongst my kit. A quick list of a dozen clothing items includes: belts, boots, field jacket, gloves, hats, long underwear, mittens, neck gaiter, pants, scarf, shirts, and socks. Additionally, when it comes to gear, I could think of another rucksacks, sewing kit, sleeping bags, snowshoes, tanker bar, tire chains, tow it all of my adult lifetime, why do you have and use this large amount of military surplus gear?"

menclature, I decided to create my own acronym to help explain my personal penchant for military surplus items. Using the word **SURPLUS**, I came up with: <u>Seriously Utilitarian</u>, <u>Reasonably</u> Priced, Long-lasting, Underappreciated Supplies. I'll be the first to admit military clothing and gear is considerably heavier than most of its lightweight constructed to handle temperature extremes (arctic, desert, and everything in-between) and rough-handling (lowoperations and many more unforgiving circumstances) for extended periods of time without failing. The bottom line is its useful stuff for what you're probably going to be doing outdoors and if you're not going on an ultralight, multiday, high-mileage backpacking trip, the weight factor probably isn't an is-sue. While the U.S. government most likely spent an excessive amount of to meet all its necessary extreme standards, you can probably get that same gear, when they are done using it, for a fraction of what Uncle Sam originally paid for it. In the past 20-years, a number of these long-existent Army Navy Stores have closed I learned a long time ago to always have their doors, since they've had an increasingly difficult time acquiring genuine military surplus items, both from the U.S. military and foreign militaries, and the cheaper civilian knock-offs (often made in China), do not meet the same high-quality standards. Since my military retirement in Feb-Well, in the spirit of true military no- ruary 2013, my primary "Go To" sources for military surplus items are both Pennsylvania-based companies. Coleman's Military Surplus LLC in Millersburg, PA is where I acquired several larger items, like my Modular Sleep System and snowshoes. They shuttered their retail location during the COVID-19 Pandemic, but their full line of authentic military surplus items is civilian equivalents, but by design it is available online at colemans.com (Like me, you can sign up for their email list.) More recently, I have frequented Priority One Surplus in Hamburg, PA. It's in crawling, thrown in trucks, airborne a plaza, just up the hill, from the largest Cabela's megastore in the U.S., along Interstate 78 between Harrisburg and Allentown (and only a 25-minute drive from my parents). If your future travel plans take you to Eastern PA, I recommend you consider stopping at Priority One. Their store is configured like a military supply room and their staff are primarily veterans. I picked up my MOLLE rucksack for \$30.00 and my money developing a piece of equipment favorite Gortex bivy sack (a waterproof cocoon) for \$20.00 there. Their website is: priorityonesurplus.com and they too have an email list you can sign up for.
