DEAR PAW'S CORNER:

We have a contractor coming soon to renovate our kitchen. I plan to keep my cat, "Freya," out of the way and in a separate room during the day. But at night, she'll want to wander the house. How do I keep her out of the kitchen? – Jim in Portland, ME

DEAR JIM: Cats are pretty wily, and I'm sure Freya will try to find a way around any barriers you set up to keep her out of the kitchen.

The best way to dissuade her from exploring the construction area, therefore, is to tempt her away with better distractions. That means moving her food and water to a new location far from the construction area (but out of heavy foot traffic) and giving her treats and attention whenever she opts to stay in the living room with you or near her bedding and food.

At night, tighten the barriers around the kitchen – if there's a door, close it. If there is plastic sheeting up, tack it to surrounding walls and tape it to the floor. Put a sheet of plywood across the entrance if necessary.

Inside the work area, make sure that the contractors put away all sharp tools and cover any containers tightly. They should clean up any debris at the end of each day and use a wet-dry vacuum to pick up sawdust and dirt. Any spills need to be cleaned completely. This will reduce the risk to Freya if she manages to get into the kitchen, and it's just good practice. ©2024 King Features Synd., Inc.





### By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II The POWA Conference - When a Meeting is more like a Family Reunion (Part 2 of 2)

two words probably best describe

the emotions coursing through my body whenever I fish a new water way for the first time. That was recently the case on Fri., May 17, at the 2024 Pennsylvania Outdoor Writers Association (POWA) Conference in Wilkes Barre, when I was one of five members signed up for the kayak fishing excurlife, but that's been down near Harrisburg, where the river is almost a mile where the river is only 300-vards wide. hemmed in by forested ridges with fishing companions were fellow POWA Members: John Allen (Cumberland Co.), Tyler Frantz (Lebanon Co.), Ben Moyer (Fayette Co.), and Wade Robertson (McKean Co.).

Our host was Brian Swingle, owner of Five Mountain Outfitters in Shickshinny. We were chomping at the bit, waiting behind the building at 9:20 AM, and introduced ourselves to Brian when he arrived to open for the day. Five Mountain Outfitters operates out of a former church building and Brian gave us a detailed tour of his facility with kayaks on the ground floor and an extensive array of fishing tackle and kayaking accessories on the top floor. After Brain covered the stretch of river we would be fishing on the map, offered some valuable fishing tips based on his experience as a former professional kayak fisherman, and we signed our mandatory release forms; we loaded up three rental kayaks for Ben, Wade, and myself. and John and Tyler's fishing kayaks they had brought along, and piled into the van for the 3-mile drive upriver to the PFBC boat launch. It was 10:45 AM until we got on the water, but it was a beautiful partly sunny day with the temperature around 70° F and ample hope the fish would be biting.

We were told we would pass by three islands floating downstream and to focus our casts along the rock-strewn shoreline, which was initially along the eastern bank, but would become prevalent along the western bank halfway downstream. I started out with a smallmouth and a wide variety of other Great Outdoors! ©WBB 2024

Anticipation and species on in the past; while my second excitement. Those rod pitched a 3-inch green Gitzit tube lure to work the bottom with its rubber tentacles. We all had limited success along the eastern bank for the first 45min. I only had one strike on my Rapala, so I decided to try the western bank near the top of the first island to do something different from my peers. When my two "Go To" lures still didn't produce within 10-minutes, I decided a radical change was in order. I switched sion on the Susquehanna River. Now, to a smaller 2-inch white Sassy Shad I've fished the Susquehanna my entire on a 1/16-ounce jig head and began employing a slower retrieve to work the bottom with intermittent bounces wide. This time we would be almost as the lure's paddle tail vibrated wildly. 90-river miles upriver in Luzerne Coun- On my second cast, a juvenile smallty, near the small town of Shickshinny, mouth took my Sassy Shad and they progressively got bigger. Sadly, around Noon, just as I was about to lift my lure picturesque rocky outcroppings. My out of the water to start another cast, a chunky 14-inch smallmouth rocketed up from the bottom and grabbed the backend of the Sassy Shad without getting to the jig's hook, thereby nipping off the critical paddle tail. I did end up catching smallmouths on a much smaller #5 Rapala and on a silver/black Gitzit, before we had to be off the water by 1:15 PM in order to return the kayaks and get to Frances Slocum State Park for our next events. Brian invited us all to return sometime on a Monday (his day off) to fish a longer stretch with him as our guide. I may take him up on his offer, since it takes time to learn new water and the bald eagles I saw seemed to be inviting me back.

Saturday evening was our annual Excellence-In-Craft Awards Banquet. As the new Awards Committee Chairman in my first-year, it culminated 4-months of work compiling 389 entries from 37 members across the 30 categories. I could not have done it without the 60+ amazing individuals who volunteered their time, experience, and expertise to serve as our judges. Amongst my outstanding judges were WBB readers: Wayne Anderson, Mark Bryan, Steve Dickinson, Carson Drake, Dr. David Mistretta, Ron Nagel, Dr. Burton Nessler, Tom O'Brien, Colton Osborne, Jesse Putnam, and Gary Weimer. - -31/2 cups oats
- -1/2 cup raisins
- -1/2 cup shredded coconut -2/3 cup sunflower seeds
- -1/2 cup toasted sesame seeds
- -1/2 cup wheat germ
- -1/2 cup oat bran
- 3 tablespoons flaxseeds - 1 tablespoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- -11/2 cups natural peanut butter
- 1 cup honey - 4 tablespoons butter, melted
- 3/4 cup Reese's Pieces

Preheat oven to 350 F. In a large bowl, let one child combine the first 10 ingredients with a big spoon. Continue stirring while another child adds the peanut butter, honey and melted butter. A prominent senator was dropped from the "Green Book"-the list of Washington societal elite who are invited to special functions. Why? Because he never attended the events. Instead, he went home each night to be with his family.


