

While we breathe and obtain oxygen from the air, remember fish breathe with their gills to obtain oxygen from the water. Do not keep a fish you plan to release out of the water any longer than necessary. That includes the cumulative time of handling it and taking photos. Maybe a few moments back in the water will be required while the fish is in your possession. Always handle fish gently to avoid damage to their gills or internal organs. A little bleeding might be OK, but a lot of blood often means the fish won't make it after being released. A deeply hooked fish within reach, especially if you are fish- requires careful work with a pair of forceps or needle-nose pliers, a plastic the fish out of the water or grabbing it hook disgorger, one of the newer hook disgorgers that look like stainless surgical tools, or a simple pencil diameter stick about a foot long. With a firm grip of the fish, the goal is to use your tool to grasp or push on the bottom curved bend of the hook to back the hook's point & barb out a little bit in order to release its attachment in the fish. If it's deep in the stomach, this may not be possible without severely injuring the fish.
