## By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II Be Proactive, Not Merely Reactive, When It Comes to Summer Safety

Sometimes.

sired outcomes can come upon you in mere seconds. I've heard it said, "Wismistakes and true wisdom comes from learning from the mistakes of others." Allow me to impart some true wisdom upon you, based on a mishap I experienced 41-years ago, which I was very fortunate to walk away from unscathed.

sophomore and junior years at Penn State, and I got a job in the maintenance department at Dorney Park, a major amusement park in Allentown, PA. I think the fact I wasn't afraid of heights and knew how to rappel played a part in why they selected a 20-year old college kid. (I did get to use my rappelling skills to check the tightness of the large bolts and soundness of the beams on their historic wooden roller coaster.) We worked 5 AM to 1:30 PM, and completed most of our routine maintenance and any necessary repairs before the park opened. After guests entered at 11 AM, we usually had "behind the scenes" tasks to perform, unless a ride broke down. At the time, Dorney Park had large grassy fields as overflow parking areas and numerous massive pavilions for large corporate picnics.

One day around noon, I was told to loader out to the back fields to roll up the flagging tape and pull out the t-posts that had been used to designate the parking area for a company picnic the previous day. I had the roughly 1500 feet of flagging tape rolled up and was working my way around the perimeter using a chain attached to a hook on the bucket loader to remove the t-posts, when I started to hear thunder in the distance. It was a race against time, to see if I could get the job completed before I got soaked by the incoming thunderstorm. I had just attached the chain to the second to last t-post and climbed back up into the tractor's seat to begin extraction, when it happened. The ominous dark clouds were still over a mile away, but the only tree in the entire field, a solitary big oak, was suddenly struck by lightning about 50-yards from where I was on the tractor. The 8N had been modified so the exhaust pipe/muffler came up vertical from the engine, instead of horizontal back underneath the tractor's frame. In a split second, every hair on my body (head and arms) stood up, as the lightning arced from the tree to the tractor's exhaust pipe. The flash of bright light, the intense heat, and

In most It was Summer 1983, between my cases being aware of your surroundings and taking a proactive approach to your personal safety will help mitigate the danger you might encounter. Please remember, the children in your life will be watching you and learning from your example. Do as I say, not as I do, doesn't cut it with kids. They'll see right through your hypocrisy and their future behavior will follow yours for good or for bad. So, set them up for success, not failure.


**Lightning** – It can strike up to 10-miles from a storm cloud. If you can hear thunder, you are potentially close enough to be struck. Avoid tall, solitary objects and don't be a tall, solitary object out in the open. Get off of or out of the water. The safest place is inside a building or a vehicle. Watch the forecast.

Water – Everyone has an excuse why they don't, but find a comfortably fitting life preserver (PFD) that works for what take the Ford 8N tractor with the bucket you do on the water, and then wear it whenever afloat. Tragic things can happen very quickly on any boat and there's not time to put on a life preserver. It's life insurance to come home safely. Insects - Tick-borne illnesses (Lyme disease, etc.) and mosquito-borne illness (West Nile virus, etc.) are very real threats in our area and must be taken seriously. Treating your clothing with permethrin and using insect repellant with DEET or picaridin on your skin is the best way to avoid bites when outdoors. Sun Exposure - Unfortunately, it's cumulative over time, so wear appropriate clothing or sunscreen with an adequate SPF to avoid skin damage/skin cancer. Sunglasses help protect your eyes from UV exposure.

Vehicles - Wear your seatbelt. Put children in proper car seats. If your UTV has seatbelts use them. On your motorcycle, ATV, or UTC wear your helmet. You know, EMTs, paramedics, and medical professionals have a name for those who don't: "Organ Donors". Arrive alive for those who love you!

**Honoring Your Parents** Honor your father and mother. —Ephesians 6:2 Read: Exodus 20:1-17


