Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II Trying Something Completely New - A Kayak Fishing Excursion for Lake Erie Walleye

When started Outdoor Oppor-

received some sage advice from Ralph Martone. At the time, Ralph was the outdoor writer for the New Castle News and one of the things he told me Hobie fishing kayaks with pedal drive was, "Never give away the exact location of your favorite hunting or fishing spots. Because while you may think you may be the only one who knows about it, there are probably a few others who consider it their 'secret spot' too and they will be mad at you and hold a grudge for a long time." I've tried to adhere to Ralph's wisdom over the past 10-years and in the spirit of good investigative reporting, I'm not going rod holders, a plastic measuring board, to reveal my source this week, when it comes to my extremely generous host who provided all the gear I required and graciously shared his expertise in how to successfully land Lake Erie walleve from a kavak.

I'll be the first to admit walleye is my favorite freshwater fish when it comes to meal time. It is simply delicious (a fact I learned from repeated trips to remote Canadian waters as a teenager). Like many others, I've made trips to Lake Erie's shallower western basin to head out from Port Clinton on charter boats to fill the cooler with walleye and I've been the guest on friends' boats out on PA's Lake Erie waters when we've traveled out several miles to find walleye holding in deeper waters. So, I was completely intrigued when my host told me he regularly went out on Lake Erie in his kayak and harvested his limit of six walleyes. Now, I've had my recreational kayak out on the lake side of Presque Isle over a half-mile and within the bay when there have been 2 to 3 foot swells, so I have tremendous respect for "big water" and know you do not attempt to kayak fish on Lake Erie unless the conditions are just right with minimal wind and therefore minimal waves. My host informed me the "windows of opportunity" come up on only a few days' notice, based on the weather forecast, and when the conditions are right, it's time to go now.

I had declined a few initial invitations because of prior commitments, but when my host asked if I was available on Monday, July 22, my wife chimed in there wasn't anything on my schedule I couldn't delay. We texted to arrange that he would pick me up at 5:30 AM for the trip up I-79 North and I wouldn't need to bring any gear other than my PA fishing license. Lake Erie permit. favorite life preserver, and cooler.

first site at 7:05 AM (sorry not more spewriting cific) and I got to watch a true professional at work. My host had refined tunities" in 2014, his "big water" kayak fishing gear and prowess on Chesapeake Bay seeking striped bass and on Lake Erie pursuing walleye for many years. So, he has two units completely outfitted to safely and confidently go out for walleye. His Hobie kayak that I used had a comfortable seat with backrest and cushion, an electronic fish finder (primarily to know water depth and forward speed), a large plastic lockable fish gripper (to avoid the walleye's sharp teeth) a back deck to strap down my Yeti cooler (for bait, water bottles, and landed fish), multiple many tools of the trade (pliers, gill clipper, etc. on retractable lanyards to avoid loss), and a stainless steel diver's stringer (to bleed out landed walleye for 30-minutes before they go in the cooler on ice). His mini-van is a customized "fishing machine" for transporting his two kayaks, all his gear, and for sleeping, since he often makes two-day trips when conditions are just right.

It took a few minutes to get comfortable with the pedal drive unit and steering with the rudder, but it soon became second-nature. Based on his guidance, we dropped our lines in when we got out into 30-feet of water and stripped the color-coded braid lines until they were 100-feet behind our kayaks. We each had two lines out trolling his favorite trolling spoon/worm harness combination with an attached nightcrawler. His guidance was to keep moving at 1.5-MPH. We were anywhere from a half-mile to one mile offshore and we went up to 1.5-miles east of the launch making circuitous drags. With his experience, he caught 2X to 3X the fish I did, but I was blessed to bring in a 16.5, 17.5, 18, 19.5, a hefty 24, and massive 28-inch walleye for my six-fish limit as we trolled from 7:30 AM to 2:30 PM. My host told me most fisherman think they have to head out much further on Lake Erie this time of year, but he's found some western basin walleye move into more eastern waters closer to shore each summer. He informed me my 28-inch "beast" was one of the largest walleve he's ever seen pulled into a kayak. It was one of my most productive fishing trips in the past 20-years and an hour-long cleaning session netted over 12-pounds of delicious walleve filets! I truly appreciate my host's hospitality, generosity, and expertise, and look forward to fishing together again, if the invitation comes! 


