





Let's Explore, What's in Store, for Our Upcoming Hunting Seasons in 2024

commentator on the Pittsburgh Penguins radio network, used to vibrantly the bingo game's ready to roll!" when grandparents, and guardians. foretelling things were going to happen in rapid progression. Now, that we've reached mid-September, we're on the verge of our many, varied PA hunting each other and it's easy to miss an opportunity, if you're not keeping track. So, in the interest of helping hunters informing family members, friends, coworkers, and employers when the hunters they know will want to spend time afield, I'm going to cover the upcoming hunting seasons and hit a few key points often overlooked.

If you've already heard a few shots in the distance, that might be eager hunters getting out for two of our earliest seasons, resident Canada geese and doves, which both opened on Labor Day, Sep. 2. One of our most underpursued species was moved to an earlier opening date a few years ago and this year squirrels (gray, black, fox, and red) become legal quarry on Sat., Sep. 14. In Western PA, deer hunters can get out into the woods two weeks earlier down in Wildlife Management Unit (WMU) 2B, comprised of most of Allegheny County and suburban portions of surrounding counties, when archery opens there on Sat., Sep. 21. That is the same day, Sep. 21, when tree stands and portable hunting blinds can first be lelands and some other public lands abide by this same policy.


When the calendar turns to October, things really get rolling when our statevehicles parked along rural roads and in remote spots as over 325,000 licensed archers head out in pursuit of antlered and antlerless deer. Duck seasons vary across the Commonwealth, but this year ducks, mergansers, and coots become legal quarry in the North, North-80. Waterfowl hunters should note the South zone opens the same day as the Northwest and North zones this year, since they had different opening days in the past. I would be remiss if I didn't mention the three Junior Hunts offered this Fall with their special requirements

One of my favorite seasons opens on Sat., Oct 19, when our early muzzleloader antlerless deer season opens for one week and permits hunters to use the seasons quickly opening one right after flintlock, percussion cap, or inline muzzleloading rifle of their choice. An often overlooked regulation found on Page 25 of the Digest states: "Archery gear mark their calendars and as means of can be carried by muzzleloader hunters providing they have an archery license and necessary fluorescent orange." That way, if an antlered deer comes through, you can use your archery gear to take a buck, while the muzzleloader is not a legal means to take an antlered deer in October. Sat., Oct. 19, is also our statewide opening day for grouse and rabbits. One of the biggest regulation changes for this year is that our statewide muzzleloader season for bear is only three days: Thur., Fri., and Sat., Oct 24-26, and coincides with the special statewide three-day firearms bear season, which is only open to junior & senior license holders, mentored permit holders, active duty military, and disabled-persons permit holders. This change in the statewide muzzleloader bear season was made to reduce harvest rates on female bears and promote stabilization of our PA bear population. Those same three days, Oct. 24-26, are also the special statewide antlerless only firearms deer season for the same gally placed out on most PA state game limited participants as bear. Oct. 26 is also eagerly anticipated by small-game hunters, since it's opening day of our statewide pheasant season in PA.

November brings opening day for wide archery deer season opens on numerous big-game species. Sat., Nov. Sat., Oct. 5. You'll start noticing more 2 is opening day of Fall turkey season, when both bearded or unbearded birds are legal quarry. However, the length of Fall turkey season varies by WMU, so please check your Digest carefully for where you plan to hunt. In our area, WMU 1A, Fall turkey season runs Nov. 2-16 this year. Our regular firearms bear west, and South Zones on Sat., Oct. season runs Nov. 23-26, Sat. thru Tues., 12. Lawrence County is in the South and includes Sunday hunting. While zone, since we are south of Interstate our regular firearms deer season opens again on the Saturday after Thanksgiving, and runs Nov. 30 thru Dec. 14, which includes Sunday hunting on Dec. 1.


