

Whatever You Choose to Pursue Outdoors. There is a Pack for That!

eclectic

regularly read things that pique my interest for any reason. Recently, I came across a story addressing Anthropology and some of the earliest technological developments attributed to mankind. I'm sure you could guess a few of them. because they came to my mind too. There was obviously the ability to start a fire, along with the discovery of the wheel for transportation. Along the lines of intellectual innovations, they listed a written alphabet, in addition to graphic illustrations (i.e. cave drawings). The one that hit close to home and I had never previously considered was the pack or bundle as a mean of moving items from one location to another. Our earliest ancestors probably initially used animal skins to carry cutting tools (early stone knives and axes), fire-starting materials, cookware, bedding (most likely other animal skins), food items, and possibly water as they lived a primitive nomadic existence as hunters and gathers.

Today we often take packs for granted. But, when you think about it, they are very common pieces of gear, and thus we have many different names for them. We have backpacks, knapsacks, rucksacks, kit bags, daypacks, packsacks, haversacks, satchels, sling bags, book bags, carry-ons, shoulder bags, fanny packs, butt packs, waist packs, dry bags, range bags, and duffle bags. Packs come in all sorts of colors and sizes (frequently measured in liters as a unit of volume). If you have a favorite outdoor pursuit, there is probably a spewide variety of camouflage patterns and they even get more specific depending upon whether you are afield with a firearm, crossbow, compound bow, or a recurve/longbow. Fishing packs are similarly specialized for fly fishermen, lure fishermen, bait fishermen, and even saltwater fishermen with their oversized gear. Then you get into specialty bags for canoeing, picnicking, photography, shooting, first aid, trapping (pack baskets), biking (panniers), horseback riding (saddlebags), mountain climbing, and the list could go on.

Probably, the four most common areas of human activity where you will observe individuals carrying a load on their back in some form of pack are: (1) students with their books and other educational materials; (2) day hikers with cision. Choose wisely! God Bless, Be those items they need for a comfortable day outdoors and most likely a few extra


I've always been items in case of emergency; (3) backsomewhat of an packers with everything they require to reader. sustain themselves (food, clothing, and When I'm looking shelter) for multiple days afield; and (4) at the newsfeed on my smartphone, I'll military service members with all the tactical and sustainment gear they need to complete their mission. I have been a member of all four categories at one point or another in my life and in the latter two, backpacker and soldier, your pack becomes your "home away from home" with everything you need to battle the elements and continue moving on successfully.

A good rule of thumb when you initially start heading afield with a pack on your back is to not exceed one tenth of your body weight. With a little experience and conditioning, that can increase to one sixth of your body weight for a multiple day excursion. So, for a 150-lb. individual, this means day hikes should be limited to 15-lbs. as you become accustomed to having a load on your shoulders and 25-lbs. will be the recommended limit when you start out on multi-night backpacking trips. Parents need to be cautious with their children and the amount of weight they are carrying in their book bags to, from, and around school. I can recall my own children when they weighed only 60 lbs. definitely shouldering loads above 10 lbs. (which clearly exceeded one sixth of their body weight) when it came to all the books and other materials they lugged around. I know there are military veterans and current service members reading this who wish the load they routinely shouldered was only one-sixth of their body weight. In the military, based on the mission and environmental conditions, it's not uncommon to be cialty pack for your activity. There are a carrying one-quarter, to as much as myriad of packs made for hunters in a one-half, of your own body weight on your back. While day packs frequently only have shoulder straps, any pack used for heavier loads and longer outings should definitely have a waist strap, since a properly fitted backpack should comfortably transfer 80% of the weight to your hips and lower body and 20% to the front of your shoulders. (The goal is put Zero percent of the weight on the top of your shoulders.)

In the 1990's, the military came out with the MOLLE (pronounced Molly) system. The Modular Lightweight Loadcarrying Equipment system has external webbing to permit users to attach a wide variety of external pouches and accessories to their pack. It is now the standard for civilian packs as well.


