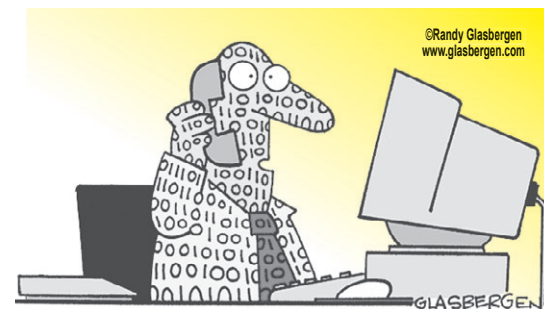



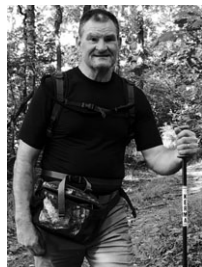

Outdoor Opportunities

Enjoy Each Part of the Hunt:
Before, During, and After (Part 1 of 6)

When I attend outdoor-focused events, like "God's Great Outdoors" at New Covenant Evangelical Presbyterian Church (Sep. 14) and the 20th Annual Sportsmen's Dinner at First Baptist Church (Sep. 21), I typically only have one regret. That is, like everyone else, I've never perfected being two places at once. So, when there are multiple seminars going on at the same time covering various subjects, I always feel like I'm missing out on great new info I could learn and potentially write about from the other presenters.

This past Sat. evening at First Baptist Church, I titled my presentation: "Enjoy Each Part of the Hunt: Before, During & After." To pique attendees' interest, I summarized what I was going to be talking about in the program like this: "Your hunt isn't just the moment you pull the trigger or release an arrow/bolt in hopes of downing a deer, bear, or other game. No, your hunt is a sequential journey involving planning, preparation, and finally, execution. There are many things to consider before, during, and after the harvest. Come learn how doing the many little things involved in a hunt can definitely increase your success and make your time afield more enjoyable." At FBC's event, presenters give two 30-minute seminars. About 10-minutes into session #1, I realized I had enough info to cover an hour-long session.

With those in attendance, I focused on the "Before", and only had enough time to hit the highlights of "During" and "After". It was at the end of my first session when the thought came to my mind, the material I had taken significant time to compile and share with those in attendance would also make an interesting series worth sharing here in the pages of the Weekly Bargain Bulletin with a much greater number of readers. Since we are on the cusp of our PA statewide archery deer season starting on Oct. 5 and many more hunting seasons will sequentially open throughout Oct. and Nov., these six pieces will give hunters a "checklist" of things to do and/or remember, and it will also provide their family members, friends, co-workers, and other non-hunters a better understanding of what all is involved in hunting.

"Before Heading to the Woods", I broke down into five sub-categories. They are: (1) Getting Yourself Ready; (2) Gear/Equipment Preparation; (3) Practice/Familiarization; (4) Scouting/Stand Selection; and (5) Think of Others. I'm going to get started and will

simply share my thoughts as space permits each week, before picking up again the next week with some transitions to make the series flow smoothly. In this entire series, I'm going to be candid and blunt, since these many learning points have come through my own experiences or from observing others' behavior and frequently their mistakes/mishaps.

(1) "Getting Yourself Ready" involves several things. If you're a regular reader, you know I place a high emphasis on safety (it's in my DNA from my military career). Statistically, the three most dangerous hazards hunters encounter are: vehicle accidents heading to/from the woods, tree stand falls, and heart attacks. If you are a hunter, especially a seasoned hunter with many hunting seasons under your belt, physical conditioning needs to become a priority at some point. Some aerobic activity (walking, cycling, etc.), some strength training (weightlifting, calisthenics, etc.), and some stretching are all recommended. Don't become another heart attack statistic when walking in the woods or dragging out a deer because you didn't put in any effort before hunting season. I know this definitely includes me and I've "upped my game" since my wife got me a Fitbit in mid-June. I've only missed my 10,000-Steps goal one day and walking our dog at least two-miles every day contributes to the total. I recently watched a gentleman who was 3-months shy of his 100th Birthday purchase a Henry .22LR lever action rifle to go squirrel hunting (he said he always wanted one) and I want to be like him when I grow up, so I keep on walking now!

"Getting Yourself Ready" also includes purchasing all your required licenses and stamps, signing them when required, and carrying them with you. I have watched others get stern warnings or citations from Game Wardens because they failed to sign their antlerless license or duck stamp before heading afield. Additionally, on a personal note (I'll try to be as tactful as possible here), condition your body to do its business shortly after waking up, both #1 and #2, before leaving the house or camp. I have encountered other hunters "making a beeline for the tree line" while walking into their stands in the dark and hopefully, they remembered to bring the appropriate resources for their post void paperwork.

Next week we'll focus on (2) "Gear/Equipment Preparation". As Pastor Tom O'Brien of Ellwood City wisely shared, "preparation creates anticipation" for all of us! **God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors!** ©WBB 2024

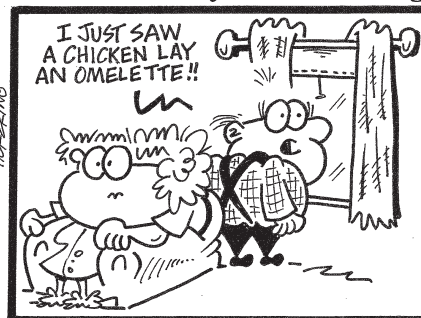
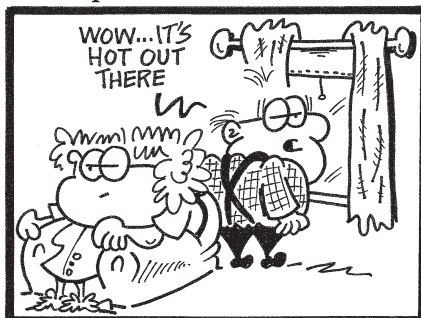

Study the techniques of good photography; you can look them up online. Composition is more important than the device you're using - whether an expensive camera or your smartphone.

Incorporate these guidelines into your photography:

- Opportunity: Rather than posing your pet, photograph them in their daily lives.
 - Eye level: Position the camera lens at the same level as your pet's eyes, rather than aiming down at them.
 - Focus: Make sure your device has a sharp focus on the pet's eyes. If the auto focus has trouble doing so, try angling slightly to one side so their snout isn't in the way.
 - Natural light: Turn off the auto flash and rely on natural light, like sunlight or a warmly lit room. This keeps pets relaxed and gives a nice glow to the image.
 - Background: Pay attention to what's behind your pet. An unscooped litter box behind Jess will really stand out when you're reviewing the photos.
 - Unusual angles: Play around with different angles and perspectives when photographing your pet. Many won't work, but you might be surprised at the ones that look amazing.

Build Tasty Stuffed Vegetable Boats

We've devoured farm-fresh fruits and vegetables from A-Z during these past months, but it seems like we've been stuck on the letter "Z" for quite some time - "Z" as in zucchini. Fat ones, skinny ones, green ones, and lots of cheap ones!

For health-conscious parents, it's a challenge to get vitamin-rich zucchini and other veggies that are so abundant right now into the picky eaters in the family. Here's a strategy that is bound to please their palettes. Let your kids help prepare "vegetable boats" filled with the taste of the food they love: pizza!

This yummy combination of Italian sausage, tomato sauce and cheese, when scooped into the halves and hollows of squash and peppers to resemble boats, will glide onto your kids' plates and into their tummies for a healthy fall meal.

STUFFED VEGETABLE BOATS

Makes 4-6 servings

- 16 ounces mild or spicy Italian sausage
- 1/2 medium onion, chopped
- 2 tablespoons green or red pepper, chopped
- 1 cup favorite prepared tomato-based pasta sauce
- 2 cups grated mozzarella cheese
- 4 medium zucchini squash, halved lengthwise (or substitute with yellow squash)
- 1 large green or red pepper
- Shredded fresh carrot and parsley for garnish (optional)

Cook the sausage in a medium frying pan until crumbled and lightly browned. Add the onion and chopped pepper. Continue to cook for 1 minute until onions and pepper are soft. Add the sauce and 1 cup of grated cheese. Stir until heated throughout. Transfer into a bowl and set aside to cool slightly.

Let your child scoop out the insides of the squash halves with a melon baller or a small ice-cream scoop to form a cavity. They'll enjoy digging around and removing the seeds. Then make some "pepper pockets" by coring a pepper and cutting it into quarters, then in half again.

Let children spoon the sausage mixture into the cavities of the squash halves and pepper pockets. Set them on a cookie sheet or baking dish.

Bake in a 350-F oven covered loosely with foil for about 30 minutes. Remove foil and top with remaining mozzarella. Return to oven uncovered for an additional 10 minutes, until vegetables are tender.

Serve with garnishes, if you wish. Or add thin carrot sticks as oars for the little boats. Serve with garlic sticks and a fruit salad on the side. © 2024 Donna Erickson. Distributed by King Features Synd.



Best Bites Extra Tips:

- Trim off a strip of squash from the curved side of the squash halves to keep the "boats" upright.

SENIOR NEWS LINE

The scams against seniors are getting worse, if that's even possible, and the thieves are becoming sneakier and more creative by the minute. We have to up our game to stay one step ahead of them and not fall victim.

It bears reviewing the typical scams. While some of these might seem to be repeats of scams that have already gone on for years, the differences are in the tactics the thieves are using.

- Romance scams - If you have a new online friend you've never met and they ask for money, it's a scam.

- Computer repair - You might get a pop-up message saying your computer has a virus and that you need to give them access to fix it. It's a scam.

- Grandparent scams - You'll get a call that is allegedly from your grandchild who is in jail and needs bail money. It's most likely a scam. Before something like this ever hap-

pens, create a code word you can use with family members as proof of who they are. A scammer won't know that secret word.

- The government - This one is all about fear, and you're made to think the IRS or the police are after you unless you send a payment, or that your Social Security number has been suspended. It's a scam.

- Banks and account fraud - This one is also about fear when you're told someone is trying to get into your account. Hang up. Call the bank and ask if they're looking for you. It's likely a scam.

Nowadays, you might not want to answer the phone if you don't recognize the number. If it's a real call and someone needs you, they'll leave a message.

Do an online search for "scams against seniors 2024" and learn all you can about the dozens of types of scams out there. The list is growing.

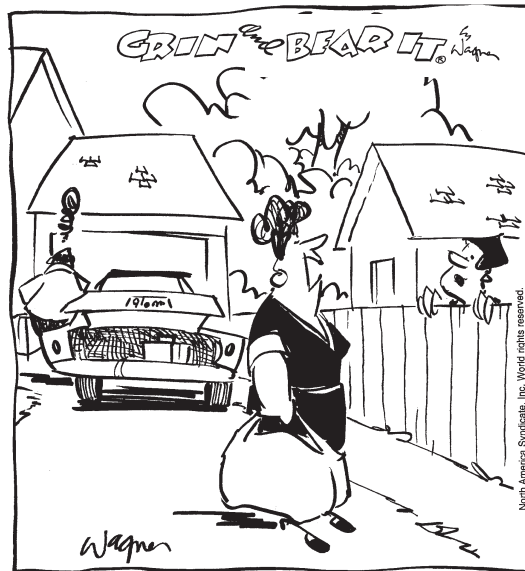

Q: My mother-in-law saved everything and some things have come down to us that we have no idea what to do with. We are retired and downsizing but want to treat my father-in-law’s memorabilia with respect. We have his uniform with insignia, medal, correspondence between them when he was in the war, his training manuals to become a pilot, emergency maps, gas mask, etc. in the event he was shot down, crew and plane photos, a detailed scrapbook, subsequent reunion materials with his bomber group. What should I do with all of this?

A: There are many collectors of World War II memorabilia. If you are interested in selling your collection, there are auctions and dealers that specialize in military and historical items. World War II memorabilia sells well at general auctions, too. If you have any weapons, guns, knives, live ammunition, or anything that might explode, check with local police for laws about safe handling and selling. You may want to consider donating your treasures to a museum; especially personal items like the photographs and scrapbook. A local museum or historical society in your father-in-law’s hometown may be interested in them. There are museums dedicated entirely to World War II, like the National WWII Museum in New Orleans and the World War II American Experience Museum in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. Some accept donations for their collections and archives. An association for World War II veterans and their families may have further advice.

- TIP: Don’t use the popular aluminum foil and baking soda system to clean antique silver. It leaves the silver with an undesirable tin-looking color.
- TIP: An unglazed rim on the bottom of a plate usually indicates it was made before 1850.
- TIP: Don’t leave anything inside old books – especially pressed flowers, paper clips, newspapers or sticky notes. They will cause stains, crease pages and do other damage. ©2024 King Features Synd., Inc.

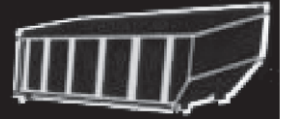

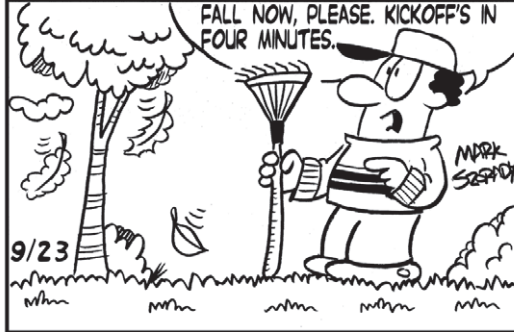

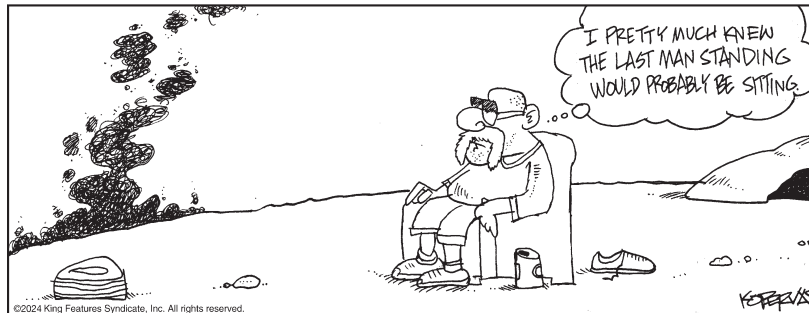
