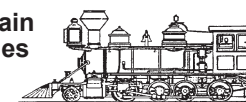

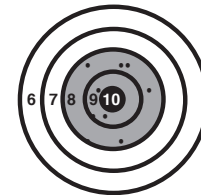

Veterans Day is a time to reflect on American history and those who made it. Fighting in World War I ended with a ceasefire on the 11th hour of Nov. 11, 1918. In the following years, Nov. 11 was observed as Armistice Day. In 1947, World War II veteran Raymond Weeks organized ceremonies on Nov. 11 to honor veterans of all wars. President Eisenhower signed the bill that made Veterans Day a national holiday in 1954.

Parades have honored veterans and celebrated patriotism since Weeks organized his first celebration, and long before then, too. We don't know what occasion this 40-star parade flag was made for, but it would have brought patriotic pride to any event. We do have a good idea of the year it was made: 1889. There were 40 states, and therefore 40 stars on the American flag, but only for a brief time. North and South Dakota became the 39th and 40th states, respec-

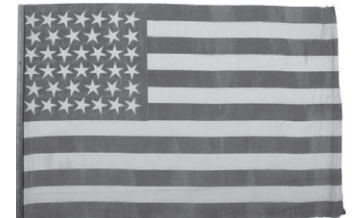

tively, on Nov. 2, 1889. Montana became the 41st state just six days later. That makes this flag especially rare. It sold for \$1,216, just passing its high estimate, at Cowan Auctions. This 40-star parade flag captures a brief, but by no means unimportant, snapshot of American history.

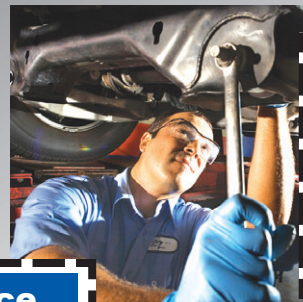

**DONNA ERICKSON'S BEST BITES**

**Spice up Your Family's Cooking With Indian-Spiced Roasted Potatoes**

I enjoy tossing a variety of spices in my family's meals, but I clearly hadn't used mustard seeds in a while – make that a long while. While cleaning out my spice drawer one day, I discovered a dented can wedged in the back with a 1985 expiration date stamped on the bottom. It might be a good year for a fine wine, but mustard seeds?

The experience had a positive outcome. I dashed off to my neighborhood natural-foods store to pick up fresh spices in bulk (in small quantities) for fall and holiday cooking. While there, I was inspired to take in that evening's cooking class "Global Flavor Gone Local," with chef Kate Moore.

Full of tips and tricks, Kate encouraged us to be spontaneous when cooking at home. With a well-stocked pantry of spices, it's easy to change the flavor profile of a dish. Like Italian? Use basil, parsley and garlic. Latin? Try cumin, coriander and chipotle. "With a willingness to experiment, kitchen miracles can happen," she said.

Here's my own take on Kate's techniques for preparing Indian-flavored roasted potatoes. My family always clamors for more of these spiced-up spuds when they're served as a side with roasted chicken, pork or grilled fish.

**INDIAN-SPICED ROASTED POTATOES**  
 Serves 6

- 6 medium, red or white skin potatoes
- 2 tablespoons minced garlic
- 1 tablespoon grated or minced fresh ginger
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 teaspoon mustard seeds
- 1 teaspoon coriander seeds
- 1 teaspoon cumin seeds
- Salt to taste

Here's the fun: Preheat the oven to 400 F. Scrub, dry and cut the potatoes into eighths, then place in a bowl.

Heat a saute pan with olive oil over medium heat and toss in a "tester" pinch of ginger. When the ginger starts to sizzle, toss in the remaining ginger, garlic and whole spices.

Cook until fragrant and spices are lightly toasted, about 1-2 minutes.

Spoon the Indian-flavored oil and ingredients into the bowl of potatoes. Add salt and toss until all sides of the potatoes are well-coated.

Spoon potatoes on a baking sheet and spread out onto one layer. Roast for 30 minutes, or until tender. Flip once to ensure even cooking.

Remove from oven and serve.

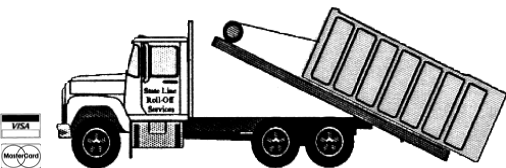

## Outdoor Opportunities

By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

**Enjoy Each Part of the Hunt: Before,  
During, and After (Part 5 of 6)**

You may not have been a Boy Scout, but I'll bet you know or have at least heard their motto at some point. It's simply "Be Prepared," and it's very applicable to my final point under "Situational Awareness" within the category "During Your Time Afield." These are subjects most people would prefer not to think about while hunting, but the mature, pragmatic approach is to at least consider the "What If's" you may potentially encounter happening to yourself or to someone else you come across out in the woods. I'm talking serious things such as: tree stand falls, slips or trips, a heart attack, a barrel obstruction, or getting temporarily disoriented. At least giving these hypotheticals some thought beforehand is a good first step.

Let's turn our attention to "Tips & Tactics," which is what most hunters are primarily thinking about while afield. Always remember, wildlife are masters of Hide & Seek, so always think small and focus on pockets of thick cover. Deer especially, like edges, places where two different cover types come together. Listen for indicator species and allow them to be an extra set of eyes or ears for you. That blue jay, crow, squirrel, or chipmunk making an alarm call may be telling you another hunter, deer, bear, or coyote is coming your way. You can never totally eliminate your human scent, so consider using a cover scent, such as raccoon, red fox, raccoon, skunk, or deer to help conceal your presence. Alternatively, attractant scents, which can be glandular or urine based may bring a deer into range. Always expect the unexpected when stationary or moving. When you stop, make sure to break up your outline by leaning against a tree or taking a concealed seat. Wildlife seem to have the uncanny ability to show up just when you decide to eat, drink, check your smartphone, adjust clothing, or relieve yourself, so move incredibly slowly and continually look closely and listen carefully. Enjoy your time in the woods and expand your knowledge by learning wildlife, bird, tree, and plant identification, which includes the many bird calls you'll hear. Finally, truly appreciate God's marvelous creation that is all around you and you are blessed to enjoy!

Lastly, there is a subcategory of "During Your Time Afield" that I like to call "Hunting Math." You may not have ever heard that term, but you're probably doing it in your mind as well. Hunting Math is the mental calculation you're making when considering how much

daylight you have remaining and the size of animal you're willing to harvest for the amount of effort involved in the entire retrieval process. Things to consider include: (1) the distance to your vehicle, home, or camp; (2) the difficulty of retrieving the carcass; and (3) what's on your schedule for tomorrow. I know how big a buck I'm willing to take a shot at over a mile from my vehicle at the last minute of daylight when the tracking, evisceration, retrieval, and trip home means it's going to be a long night and definitely well after midnight before the evening's over. Additionally, there are places I hunt where I know it will be easier to take 2-hours to head home and get my canoe to get a deer or bear out by water, rather than struggle recovering it on a cart entirely uphill, over rocks, and around toppled trees. Give it some thought before you pull the trigger or release an arrow/ bolt back in that swamp, down in that ravine, or across that stream, since that's when the real work starts.

Now, it's time to shift our attention to "After" and specifically "After Taking the Shot." I know there will be adrenaline pumping and many thoughts/emotions going through your mind when you finally get a shot. But, you need to quiet your mind and body in order to be very deliberate about your next steps. Initially in those first few seconds, you need to very attentively look and listen. Your focus needs to be on the two subcategories of "Mark the Spot" and the "Animal's Reaction." Immediately make a mental note of exactly where the game was when you shot. What was the animal's reaction to your shot? Did it drop down, jump up, arch its back, get knocked off its feet, have no apparent reaction, run off, limp off, or do something entirely different? Did you hear it fall down or crash into trees as it took off? When you first walk over to where the game was located when you shot, it's time to put on your forensic thinking cap and analyze the scene. Do you see blood, hair, fat, stomach contents, etc.? Is there an immediate blood trail or clearly disturbed leaves or broken brush to indicate the animal's direction of travel? I recommend you mark the initial spot where you connected with your quarry with something orange (hat, vest) or use flagging tape or toilet paper during daylight, or a chem-light after dark. If you've hit an animal, you have an ethical commitment to exert all necessary time and effort to recover your quarry, whatever it takes. **How often are lost pets found and returned? Prevent your pet from becoming a statistic**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My dog “Shakes” is a “bolter” – he will bolt out the door and straight into the street if I’m not careful. I worry constantly about him getting lost in the woods nearby. If that happens, what should I do? I feel that lost pets don’t get found very often.

- Jamie B. in Egypt, Maine

DEAR JAIME: Most dogs who get lost are found and returned to their owners at fairly high rates – between 81% and 97%, according to a 2012 report. That doesn’t make it any less stressful to their owners, who must scour the neighborhood and put up signs to find their dogs.

The statistics for cats are much worse, with only 45% to 72% being returned to their owners. A bunch of things make it harder to find a lost cat: no ID tag, if the cat’s collar breaks away on an obstacle. Cat owners wait much longer than dog owners to report their cat missing – probably because they feel most cats will come home on their own.

Those stats aside, Shakes would benefit greatly from being trained not to react when the front door opens. Each day, do about 15 minutes of training with him:

- Put Shakes on a leash and lead him toward the front door. Command “sit.”
- Reach out for the front doorknob. If Shakes starts forward, bring your hand back to your side and command “sit” again.
- Repeat the doorknob reach until he no longer reacts but remains sitting. When he does this, give him a tiny treat.
- Progress to turning the knob, opening the door and leaving the door open. Shakes should remain sitting for each level to be successful.

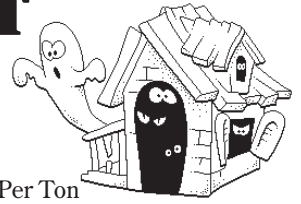

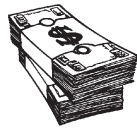

# PROPER RECYCLING LEAF AND YARD WASTE

A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence  
and Mercer Counties

Almost every home generates yard waste. Pennsylvania defines yard waste as leaves, grass clippings, garden residue, tree trimmings, chipped shrubbery and other vegetative material. Together with food scraps, these organic materials make up almost 30% of our waste stream.

Municipalities with a population greater than 5,000 (mandated municipalities) are required to offer collection programs for "Leaf Waste". Pennsylvania defines Leaf Waste as leaves, garden residues, shrubbery and tree trimmings, and similar materials, but not including grass clippings. The reason grass clippings are not included is because grass gives off odors in the form of Ammonia if not properly managed. Facilities that accept grass clippings require a special, more stringent permit. Consequently, these facilities are not as common as Leaf Waste composting facilities.

Burning leaf and yard waste is illegal in mandated municipalities. For other municipalities, burning leaves is a violation of the Clean Air Act because of the harmful emissions and nuisance created from the smoke.

Yard waste blown or dumped into the street can block culverts and storm drains causing flooding and other issues. Chemical residues from yard waste fertilizers, pesticides, and herbicides can also make their way into our waterways through improperly managed yard debris.

Residents have several options for dealing with yard waste.

## Composting

Composting at home is an easy and inexpensive way to manage your yard waste and some food scraps (no meat, bones, or oily foods). The final product of composting is...compost! It is a great product that can be used as a soil amendment, mulch, or as part of a potting mix. Visit the County website and download our booklet "Compost: Keep it at Home" for more information.

## Grasscycling

Grasscycling is easy, especially if you have a mulching mower. Simply cut the grass and leave the clippings lay. Grass clippings are high in Nitrogen. Leaving them lay prevents the removal of this valuable fertilizer and reduces the need to fertilize your lawn. Proper mowing is important with grasscycling. You may need to mow more frequently in the spring and less later in the year.

## Chipper/Shredders

Chippers are used to break down wood into wood chips. Shredders are used to turn smaller materials such as twigs and leaves into a shredded material. There are different styles and strengths available. Light duty models are made to handle twigs and small branches while heavy duty models can handle thick branches. The final product can be used as a mulch or composted.

## Municipal Curbside Collection

Mandated municipalities are required to provide seasonal curbside pickup of leaf and waste and provide other opportunities for residents throughout the rest of the year. Check with your municipality for your schedule. Place your material in brown yard waste bags as these bags are compostable. Most yard waste composting operations will not accept material in plastic bags because they require significant labor to open the bags and bags inevitably entangle and damage expensive equipment.

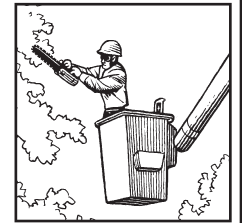

**Our Daily Bread**  
Search My Heart, God

People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart. 1 Samuel 16:7 • READ 1 Samuel 16:4-12

To reduce food waste, a supermarket chain in Singapore sells slightly blemished fruits and vegetables at lower prices. In one year, this initiative saved more than 850 tons (778,000 kg) of produce that previously would've been thrown out for not meeting aesthetic standards. Shoppers soon learned that outward appearances—scars and quirky shapes—don't affect flavor and nutritional value. What's on the outside doesn't always determine what's on the inside.

The prophet Samuel learned a similar lesson when he was sent by God to anoint the next king of Israel (1 Samuel 16:1). When he saw Eliab, the firstborn son of Jesse, Samuel thought he was the chosen one. But God said: "Do not consider his appearance or his height . . . People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart" (v. 7). Out of Jesse's eight sons, God chose the youngest, David—who was tending his father's sheep (v. 11)—to be the next king.

God is more concerned with our hearts than with outward credentials—the school we attended, what we earn, or how much we volunteer. Jesus taught His disciples to focus on purifying their hearts of selfish and evil thoughts because "what comes out of a person is what defiles them" (Mark 7:20). Just as Samuel learned not to consider outward appearances, may we, with God's help, examine our hearts—our thoughts and intentions—in all that we do. By Jasmine Goh

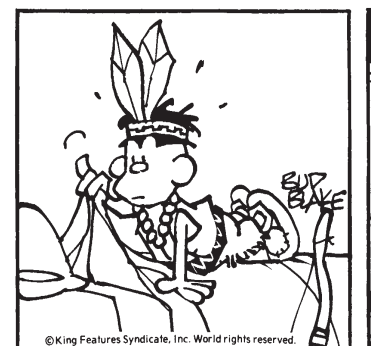
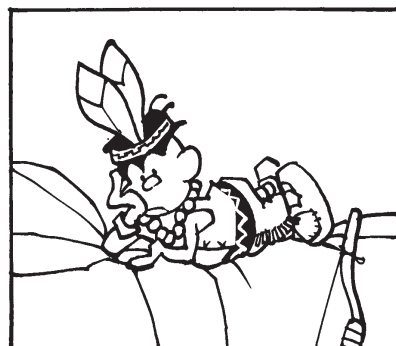

### Keeping our balance

How long can you stand on one leg? This balance ability is apparently a good indicator of how we're aging ... or so say several researchers. Some researchers pay attention to this standing business because they think it indicates longevity. Others think a lack of that ability can point to a cognitive decline.

If you want to check your balance, stand up and keep your eyes open, don't hold onto anything, and stand on one leg without any support, lifting one leg off the ground and bent at the knee. If you're between 50 and 59, that standing time should be 37 seconds. From 60-69, aim for 30 seconds. Between 70 and 79, shoot for 19 seconds, and over

80, aim for a bit over 5 seconds. Another source says in your 50s, aim for 40 seconds. In 60s, try for 20 seconds. In your 70s, the goal would be around 10 seconds.

If you struggle with standing for those lengths of time, there are ways to improve your balance. You can practice standing but use something for support until you get the hang of it. You'll strengthen the muscles of your legs that way. Or try dancing and walking up stairs.

Take a look at the Mayo Clinic website for suggestions on how to improve your balance in general. At [mayoclinic.org](http://mayoclinic.org), do a search for "balance exercises," where you'll find dozens of articles. Pay attention to the ones that talk about strengthening your core muscles - your lower back, hips, stomach and pelvis. With a stronger core, you'll have better overall balance. The good news about core exercises is that you can do them at home and don't need to go to the gym.
