week's "Outdoor Opportunities," you'll see I shifted the focus onto "After Taking the Shot." Well, little did I know that antlerless deer season. Sometimes, an entire hunt boils down to 15-seconds. That was the elapsed time from when I heard the mature doe being chased behind me just down the steep hillside until she stopped momentarily 25-yards shoulder, neck, and head. However, I had a good sight picture on her vitals to take the shot with my muzzleloader. After reloading, my forensic trail began with the projectile lodged in a small a hit. I followed disturbed leaves for erly. (Remember to bring a pen to fill 30-yards before the blood trail began. out your tag!) I like to attach my tag downhill through thick saplings. After my personal preference, a small plas-30-more yards of following evidence, I found where she had expired. Allow me to share additional thoughts concerning "After Taking the Shot." One big question has always been, "How are, if it is archery season, an arrow or bolt kills by blood loss, so you are typito wait an hour, unless I either saw or heard the animal go down. Conversely, a projectile (bullet, slug, patched round ball, etc.) kills by hydrostatic shock and the corresponding wound channel, so less time is frequently waited before taking up the trail. Other things to consider include: daylight remaining, precipitation coming in, other hunters in until daylight the next morning. Pay close attention to the blood trail, noting the color, volume, spread, and consisalso look out ahead at concealed locations. Your quarry may be hidden in a blown-down fallen tree or thick brush clump. Wounded animals are very intelligent and will try to shake you off their track. ### Art Nouveau

In design, the line between art and science isn't always clearly drawn. This has been true for centuries. One of the most influential

figures in the art nouveau movement of the late 19th to early 20th century was a scientist, not an artist.

Beginning in 1889, biologist Ernst Haeckel published a series of books called "Art Forms in Nature" that captured the geometric structure and intricate beauty of sea life, microscopic

organisms, plants, animals and insects. While art nouveau designs are stylized and exaggerated, especially human figures, the influence of nature, especially as captured by Haeckel. is clear in the organic asymmetrical shapes and the use of plants, animals, birds and insects as subjects or motifs.

This lamp shaped like a cluster of mushrooms with long stems and graceful curving shapes may not have been made in the art nouveau period, but it is definitely art nouveau style. Its leaded glass shades. bronze base and nature inspiration are reminiscent of Tiffany lamps, themselves emblematic of art nouveau, but compared to them, it was a bargain. While authentic Tiffany lamps can sell for record-setting prices of thousands of dollars, this mushroom lamp sold for \$344 at a Hindman auction.



Dr. Tiffany Gholson had seen crime impact her small American city of East Saint Louis, Illinois, in many ways. By 2023, however, the town recorded a 31 percent drop in homicides and a 37 percent drop in crime overall. What happened? A partnership. Working together, the city's Public Safety Enforcement Group—including the state and city police, the city school district, and a faith organization combined efforts to turn the tide for all citizens.

"We say it's a marriage," Dr. Gholson stated, with all members of the city partnership joining in to help citizens. The school district's Wraparound Wellness Center, which she leads, involves school social workers, nurses, and staff to support kids impacted by crime or accidents. Other agencies share their strengths. Police commit to talk more with people on the street—and listen.

The psalmist David wrote, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" (Psalm 133:1). "Harmony," David added, "is as refreshing as the dew from Mount Hermon" (v. 3 nlt). David was referring to people who share a unifying faith in God. Rather than divided by doctrines or politics, we are one. The concept may feel elusive. yet it blesses all. It's a beautiful goal for believers to show concern for one another—especially in our cities desperately in need of the love of Jesus. By Patricia Raybon





ANSWER: Changing your body's circadian rhythm isn't always easy, and after such a long time, it will take longer for you. But it shouldn't be as difficult as you might fear. When people fly to the other part of the world, they need to get accustomed to a new sleep schedule, and it usually doesn't take more than a week or two for them to get accustomed. For you, it will be difficult learning to be up during the day, which is more of a behavioral issue than a circadian-rhythm issue.

The first advice I give is to push your internal time clock forward, not backward. Try to stay up two hours or so later each day until you get to a bedtime that works with your family (if appropriate) and goals. Your body has an easier time moving forward than backward.

Bright light can be your friend or your enemy. You want bright light when you wake up, not right before bed. Computers, phones and tablets all put out light that signals your brain to wake up, so don't use these before bed. Making sure that your bedroom is dark when you want to sleep is something you probably have already done, but it's still worth mentioning.

Caffeine is very helpful to a lot of people, so if you partake, do so when you awaken, not before bedtime. Some people metabolize caffeine slowly, so if you do, don't have any

caffeine for at least 8 hours before planning to go to sleep.



## **PROPER RECYCLING • RECYCLING MYTHS**

A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties (2)

Recycling has evolved, becoming integrated into all aspects of our society and economy and a way of life for most people. Recycling became commonplace almost three decades ago, but many myths and misconceptions about it have persisted through the years.

#### Mvth 1: Recycling should be free. Mv Recyclables are worth something.

This is a long-standing myth that pre-dates mainstream recycling. Prior to around 1990 organizations and groups could fund raise by collecting items such as glass bottles, newspapers, and cans. These materials had some value for collection at the time.

A major selling point in the early days of recycling was that our municipalities could make enough money from the sale of recyclables to pay for recycling programs. This quickly turned out to not be true, but this information became a persistent myth.

The influx of materials from new recycling programs overwhelmed the fledgling markets. The law of supply and demand activated and increased volumes of materials going through the programs diminished the value of many materials.

Some materials such as aluminum and steel cans retained value which is why many people collect and redeem their own cans. Think about it - if your plastic, paper and other recyclables had any value - wouldn't we see more people collecting and turning them in for monev as we do with aluminium cans?.

The recyclables in your bin are worthless in their current state. Surprised? read on...

#### Myth 2: My municipality or hauler is making money on my recyclables

Unless your municipality or hauler owns a material recovery facility, the technical term for a recycling center, they are not making money on your recyclables. There is a significant cost to get a recycling truck and driver to your home and transport your materials to recycling center. Then the trash must be removed, and the remaining recyclables must be sorted, separated by type, and baled by expensive equipment. Only after this process do the materials have value and are ready to be marketed. Think of recycling as "urban mining". Instead of raw materials being extracted from the earth and refined before they can be used, recycling provides raw materials that need minimal processing. Perhaps the biggest advantage to recycling is the energy saved and consequently the money saved by energy avoidance.

Recycling centers generate a profit but financial success in recycling can be difficult even when recycling markets are good. Aluminum cans and cardboard are materials that usually keep recycling centers' budgets in the black.

#### Myth 3: If I put something in my recycling bin they will find a way to recycle it at the recycling center.

This is known as "wishcycling" and is one of the biggest problems plaguing recycling. Unacceptable items (a nice way of saying "trash") must be removed from the true recyclables and landfilled or incinerated. The average contamination rate is approximately 25% meaning that one in four items placed out for recycling must be removed to be disposed of properly. It is estimated that 20% of the cost of recycling is used to address trash placed in recycling bins.

There are many reasons why people place trash items into recycling bins. Some people have good intentions and believe they are helping by putting these items into their recycling bins. In some situations, education is lacking and people genuinely do not know what to recycle. There are also people who are just cheap and put trash into their recycling bins to avoid paying for proper disposal. This can be a major problem for volumebased programs where people have to buy bags/tags or are only permitted to put out a limited amount of regular trash collection. The result in this situation is people who are properly participating are paying for the people who are not.

Be sure to follow the rules for your program and keep in mind there may be differences between haulers and even neighboring municipalities depending on what recycling center is used. In general, all local programs collect plastic bottles and jugs (if it's not a bottle/jug it's trash!), metal cans, cardboard, magazine, and newspaper.

#### If it's not listed as recyclable for your program do not put it in your recycling bin!

#### Myth 4: Pizza boxes are recyclable.

You're half right on this one. The lid, as long as it is clean, can be torn off and recycled but the greasy bottom is trash. Grease and food residue is a problem for paper recyclers and can result in entire batches of paper pulp being ruined.

#### Myth 5: It's plastic so it is recyclable.

Plastic is one of the most confusing materials when it comes to recycling and is often "Wishcycled": Locally, recycling programs accept plastic bottles and jugs. The key words are "bottles and jugs". That means no clam-shell (food take out) containers, butter tubs, yogurt cups, party cups, toys and so forth. What is a bottle/jug? Think plastic primarily with screw top lids (sport drinks, condiments, detergent

bottles, shampoo, milk, and soda pop) and with the top section being narrower than the bottom.

The recycling symbol containing a number that is found on many plastic items is also misleading. This symbol has nothing to do with recycling; its purpose is to identify the plastic's resin. Promoting plastic recycling by number is still very popular. Most local programs accept #1 and #2 plastic, but, it still has to be a bottle or jug!

Plastic recycling is limited because the chemical make up and physical properties of plastic vary. Plastic may have UV stabilizers, flame retardants, hardeners, or softeners. Different resins melt at different temperatures. Quantity of material is also important. Plastic bottles and jugs make up almost 90% of residential plastic. Plastic is a light material that doesn't compact well. This impacts transportation which relies on weight and quantity to make recycling a particular material cost-effective.

Another challenge to plastic recycling is that some plastic items consist of multiple layers of different plastic. Drink and food pouches contain different layers and it is not uncommon for clamshell containers to have a lid that is a different plastic resin than the bottom.

Unfortunately, for most plastic, markets do not exist or they are far and few between because of the chemical and physical complexities of plastic.

#### Myth 6: Recycling programs are all the same.

Recycling programs can vary significantly. Recycling centers, the proximity to available markets, and ability to transport materials all factor into what can be recycled locally. Residents that live in or near metropolitan areas can usually recycle a broader range of items because of the number of households, and therefore, greater quantities of materials as well as the availability and proximity to manufacturers that can use recycling feed stocks. Residents that move are often surprised by differences in recycling programs between states and even nearby communities.

#### Myth 7: It has a recycling symbol on it so I can put it in my recycling bin.

The recycling symbol is one of the most easily recognizable symbols. It is frequently used indiscriminately on items, which leads to confusion. It may indicate recyclability or that an item contains recycled content. Just because an item has a recycling symbol does not mean that it is recyclable in your local program. Be sure to recycle only what is the list of acceptable materials provided to you by your municipality or hauler! Don't rely on the recycle

#### Myth 8: Recycling will save me money.

This myth ties together with some of the other myths already discussed. In the early days of recycling, we were told we could save money by recycling. Our expectation is a lower trash/ recycling bill that puts more money into our pockets. Costs have risen over the past decades and where recycling used to be "free" it now has a cost to it. Recycling does save us money - but not how we think. Recycling saves us money by lowering the cost of the products we buy. Energy, resources, transportation, and processing, all elements of manufacturing, are expensive. Recycling saves significant amounts of these, because mining, extraction, and refining raw materials is expensive. This saves businesses money, which in turn results in lower prices of the items we purchase. We may not directly see the money that we "saved" in our pockets, but it is there!

#### Myth 9: Plastic bags are recyclable so I can put my recyclables in them.

Plastic bags are a nightmare at the recycling center and plastic bags that end up there will NOT get recycled. Plastic bags must be ripped open to release their contents and get tangled in the cogs, gears and conveyers of recycling centers. It is not uncommon for recycling centers to shut down multiple times a day to remove them. Plastic bags are an expensive problem for recycling centers.

The good news is that plastic bags are very recyclable, but they have to go to the right place. Many local grocery and department stores accept plastic bags for recycling. Be sure to recycle your plastic bags, just don't put them in your recycle bin!

#### Discover a Surprise Inside Spaghetti Squash

When you look over the colorful choices of squash in various goofy shapes and

sizes at your market this week, tell your kids to snoop carefully to find an extrafun variety you may have forgotten about or never tried – spaghetti squash!

The oblong, light-yellow squash, which is approximately 8-10 inches in length, is packed with healthy nutrients, low in calories, and high in fiber. Best of all, it has a great appeal for kids because there's a surprise inside!

To the delight of your entire family, you'll discover that once it's baked, the flesh of the squash comes out in long strands that look like noodles. Its buttery, mild and slightly sweet flavor is ideally suited to be topped with tomato sauce and grated Parmesan cheese, mimicking a bowl of traditional spaghetti.

On another occasion, serve it as a tasty side dish tossed with pesto, a garlicflavored herb butter, or mixed vegetables and feta cheese. And when you prepare a roast, set the sliced meat and juices over the "noodles" for a robust weekend meal.

Here are a few easy steps for preparing spaghetti squash, with a few tips tossed in to make the work easier when handling it:

Preheat oven to 350 F. Wash the outside of a 2-1/2- to 3-pound spagnetti squash and pat dry. Cut in half lengthwise. Like most varieties of winter squash, it can be difficult to cut through the hard shell. I pierce the squash in several places with the tip of a knife and put it in the microwave for 2-3 minutes or more, depending on its size, to soften it a bit. Let it rest for a few minutes, then slice in half with a sharp knife.

Scoop out the seeds. A melon baller and small ice-cream scoop are easy-tohandle kitchen tools for school-age kids to use if they are assisting you with

Place the squash halves cut side down on a baking sheet coated with cooking spray or lined with parchment paper. Bake for an hour, or until easily pierced with a fork. Cool for 15 minutes.

Scoop out insides with a fork to remove the noodle-like strands. Place in a serving bowl or on a small platter. Top with preferred toppings or combine with butter, seasonings or cooked vegetables. Serves 3-4. © 2024 Donna Erickson.

## CITY OF 👶 **NEW CASTLE** RECYCLING INFORMATION



Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Castle are required by state and local laws to recycle at their curb. Property managers must provide recycling for housing, condo, or apartment complexes for situations where they arrange for trash disposal. Act 101 and New Castle provide penalties for recycling violations.

Contact: Aiken Refuse, 724-758-9400, for information about your account and questions about the program. Contact New Castle for bins (when available)—724-656-3568.

How are Materials Collected: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

**When:** Contact Aiken Refuse for your schedule.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Residents purchase special tags for bulky items through the City's contractor, Aiken Refuse. Tags are available for purchase from Aiken Refuse's website.

Leaf & Yard Waste (excluding grass): Leaf waste must be placed in a brown paper leaf bag and put out during your normal trash pickup. Contact the City or Aiken for the schedule.

Christmas Trees: Aiken Refuse will pick up Christmas Trees at no charge to their customer base between Jan 4 – Jan 14 on normal garbage days. The tree must be free of decorations and trees greater than 8' must be cut into 4

Only bottles, jugs, cans, and clean paper are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not place materials in plastic bags and do not include any items not listed. Acceptable materials may periodically change so always follow the information provided from your hauler.

Aiken Refuse has the right to reject recycling bins that contain nonrecyclable materials.

Businesses must also recycle, but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

**USEFUL INFORMATION** 

Recycling can be confusing because what is accepted as recyclable may be different between hauling companies and communities. Recycling programs are driven by markets and vary from region to region and state to state. Newer residents that move to our community are often surprised by the differences.

### "Wishcycling" and Contamination

Contamination occurs when trash/unacceptable materials are placed in your recycling bin. With wishcycling people mean well, but unintentionally hurt recycling programs by placing the wrong materials into their bins. Examples include plastic toys, food containers, tubing, or buckets. When placed in the recycling bin, these and similar items must be physically removed and then landfilled. It is estimated that up to 20% of the cost of recycling is used to deal with items that should have been placed in the trash. Items that are not listed as recyclable WILL NOT get recycled. This includes plastic bags.

Plastic is the most confusing material because it comes in a variety of forms and resins that are chemically different. People often think that because something is "plastic" that it is recyclable. This is not the case. The same holds true with the "recycling" symbol and number commonly found on plastic items. The purpose of the symbol and number is to indicate the resin type. It has nothing to do with recycling!

Instead, focus on the shape of item. When it comes to recycling, think "plastic bottles/jugs, metal cans, and clean paper." If you're holding a plastic item, consider if it is a bottle. For example, butter tubs, yogurt containers, and clamshell/take-out food containers are plastic and usually have a recycling symbol and number on them. But—they are not a bottle/jug and belong in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out.

#### **How to Prepare Your Recyclables**

A simple rinse of food/beverage bottles and jugs is all that is needed. Cardboard should be flattened and mixed papers (magazines, junk mail, newspapers) can be placed in your bin loosely or in a brown paper bag. Do not put any materials in plastic bags. Plastic bags must be ripped open. And loose bags iam

conveyor belts and gears. They are a significant cost to manage when they get into the system and will not get recycled at the recycling center. Many local grocers accept plastic bags for recycling.




