Imagine taking a hungry bite into a warm grilled cheese. Yum! Good comfort food, right? Now imagine eating this same sandwich, but this time, there are crispy pickled jalapeno pepper rounds tucked inside. Now that's a crunchy bite and a tasty transformation! My family likes to add these kicky pepper rounds to just about anything, whether they top nachos, fish or beef tacos, enchiladas, and tortillas – or they're tucked in a bun with a brat when we gather with friends for a picnic at the baseball park.

You can make these fresh and yummy pickled jalapeno peppers in minutes in your kitchen with your pre-teen. Discover the big difference in texture and flavor. Toss the easy-to-prepare and peppery-to-eat crunch on your favorite South of the Border recipe and say, "Ole!"

EASY PICKLED JALAPENO PEPPERS
Makes about 2 pints
– 1 cup white vinegar
– 1 cup water
– 4 tablespoons sugar, or more to taste (adding more sugar turns down the heat)
– 2 cloves garlic, sliced in half
– 1 tablespoon salt
– 7 fresh jalapeno peppers (from the produce area of your market), thinly sliced
– 2 fresh red or yellow mini sweet peppers, thinly sliced
– 2 pint-sized glass jars

Stir together the vinegar, water, sugar, garlic and salt in a cooking pot, and bring to a boil. Add sliced jalapeno and sweet peppers, stir, turn off heat, and let sit for 10 minutes.

Remove peppers with a slotted spoon to jars, then fill to the top with remaining liquid. Cool. Keep refrigerated and serve with favorite dishes for up to one month. Cook's Note: The oils in fresh jalapeno peppers can irritate your skin and can be painful if you touch your eyes. You may wish to wear deli or rubber gloves when slicing the peppers. 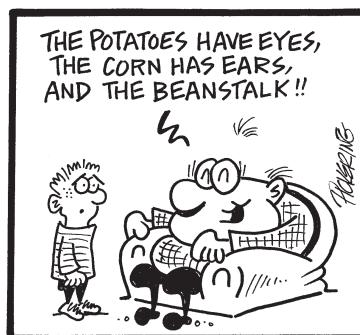
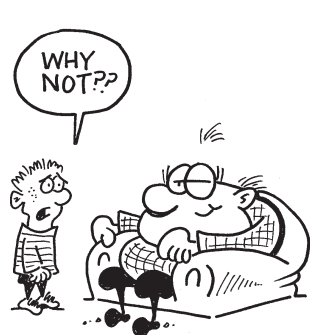

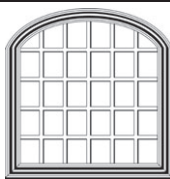

"Ain't No Grave"

If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. 1 Corinthians 15:14
READ 1 Corinthians 15:12-22

Even as country music legend Johnny Cash was approaching death, he was determined to keep making music. His final album, American VI: Ain't No Grave, was recorded in the final months of his life. The title song, Cash's version of a hymn by Claude Ely, gives insight into his final thoughts as we hear him sing of his hope of the resurrection. His famously deep voice, though weakened by his declining health, declares a powerful testimony of faith.

Johnny's hope wasn't simply in the fact that Jesus was resurrected on Easter Sunday morning; he believed that one day his own physical body would also be resurrected, and he'd rise again.

It's an important truth to affirm because even in the days of the apostle Paul, people denied a future physical resurrection. Paul strongly critiqued their argument when he wrote, "If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith" (1 Corinthians 15:13-14).

Just as the grave couldn't hold Jesus' body, one day all those who have faith that He was resurrected "will be made alive" (v. 22). And in our resurrected bodies, we'll enjoy all eternity with Him on a new earth. That's reason to sing! By Lisa M. Samra

When the Message is Meant for You

This week, I've decided to share a recent experience I had, which really made me think, and I believe is worth sharing as this edition of the Weekly

Bargain Bulletin comes out as we prepare to celebrate Easter.

On Thu., Mar. 27, I made one of my 5-hour treks across PA to visit my parents in Allentown. I enjoy bringing along ingredients to make one of our meals. Usually, it's steak or a roast, but this time I went with one of my dad's favorites: Reuben sandwiches. Now, over the course of Feb. and Mar., I perfected my Reuben and Rachel sandwich recipes with quality ingredients from the Cheese House in New Wilmington. It just so happened I arrived at the Cheese House right around noon and when I passed the cash registers, the Fri., Mar 28 edition of the Weekly Bargain Bulletin was not there yet. (FYI – the WBB paper editions are distributed on Thursdays.) I went back to the deli counter and picked up the sliced corned beef, roast turkey, and Swiss cheese I needed for our Reuben and Rachel sandwiches. I was very pleasantly surprised to see the new WBBs had arrived while I was waiting at the deli counter. I picked up three copies: one for my parents, one for my uncle, and a third for my files. It was 12:15 PM when I finally got on the road and made my way up to Interstate 80, which comprises the majority of my trip.

Now, if you are a regular reader, you might remember my Mar. 28 piece was titled, "Fishermen Aren't the Only Ones Out There Pursuing Trout in PA Waterways," and its focus was on Great Blue Herons. In my last paragraph, I mentioned other birds, mammals, and even fish that will consume PA trout, given the opportunity. One of the avian species I covered was bald eagles. I'm blessed to encounter a bald eagle about once a week, on average, during my outdoor ramblings. During my tour in Alaska, I observed bald eagles taking salmon from the Chilkat River near Haines and here in PA I've seen them swoop down and take panfish, bass, and even small carp from lakes and rivers. As I wrote that piece, I recall thinking, I've never had the privilege to witness a bald eagle with a trout in its talons, but someday I hope to see it.

Well, the 250+ mile drive across I-80 on Mar. 27 was going by fairly uneventful until I got out to Luzerne County. For

truckers, salesmen, and others who frequently travel I-80 across the Commonwealth, you'll recognize what I'm talking about when I mention that before I-80 crosses over the Nescopeck Creek around Mile Marker 250 (the worst bend on I-80 in PA and the site of road construction right now), there is a stretch of the Nescopeck Creek at MM 249 that was relocated by the highway engineers when they built I-80 to avoid constructing two additional bridges over the meandering waterway. At that point, the Nescopeck now flows through a steep man-made rocky canyon for almost a half-mile. As I was heading eastbound at 65 MPH, I saw a large bird barely clearing the treetops off to my left. It came up out of the manmade Nescopeck Creek canyon with something in its talons and proceeded to fly over the westbound lane only 50-feet in the air. At that point, I positively identified the large bird as a bald eagle, based on its prominent white head and tail feathers. As our paths interested, I looked up when it crossed over the eastbound lanes and it was less than 50-yards in front of me. It clearly had a trout in its talons and I can say with almost absolute certainty it was a rainbow trout, based on the fish's distinct coloration.

Now, some might say it was luck, others could call it fate, that on the very day my column came out mentioning bald eagles as potential predators of PA trout and I had thought about how I had never seen it when I typed those words, it actually happened. Well, I don't have enough "faith" in randomness, luck, or fate to believe that for a moment. I asked Google how long I'd been alive at that point and the astonishing answer came back: 22,568 days. No, I choose to believe God, who I am privileged to have a personal relationship with through His Son, Jesus Christ, truly wants to give each one of us the desires of our hearts. At that very moment, God tangibly demonstrated He truly knows me, He loves me, and He is an integral part of my life every moment of every day. Can you say that? As we think about Christ's horrific crucifixion on Good Friday and His glorious resurrection on Easter morning, it is not about religion and being religious. Rather, it is about a personal relationship and asking Christ into your heart and life, so that you too can know His love and His desire to be a central part of your life. This Easter Sunday, it is my prayer you will attend the Church of your choice and truly listen to the Resurrection message with an open mind and receptive heart, and then take the next step by accepting Christ as your Lord and Savior! (Read John 3:16) Allow me to welcome you to God's family!

God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors!

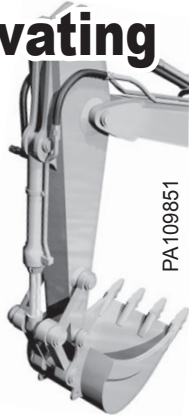

Q: My husband collected a series of gold-plated baseball cards from Danbury Mint a while back. He is downsizing and trying to sell these cards. To date, we have found no one who is interested. We have contacted Danbury Mint to see if we can find a value for the cards he has and they have not been helpful. Could you please offer some guidance as to whom we should contact? We have tried local sporting goods companies and some auction houses.

A: Danbury Mint made gold-plated baseball cards from 1996 to 2003. They released a new collection each year. The cards are made of

cardstock with a very thin layer of gold. Sets of 50 cards bound in an album sell for about \$30 to \$100 at auctions and resale sites like eBay. The website Sportlots.com values most of the individual cards at about \$2 each. Items like these that are marketed as "limited edition" or "collector's edition" usually have relatively low values on the secondary market. Many people buy and save them with the intent to resell, so the collectibles market gets flooded.

There is little value to the gold in the cards because such a small amount is used.

• TIP: Don't wrap things for storage in newspapers. The ink can yellow paper, fabrics and ceramics.

RECYCLING INFORMATION



Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of Ellwood City Borough are required by state and local laws to recycle at their curb. Property managers must provide recycling for housing, condo, or apartment complexes for situations where they arrange for trash disposal. Act 101 and Ellwood City provide penalties for recycling violations.

How are Materials Collected: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: Every other week. Contact your hauler for your schedule.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Yes. Year-round tag program for large/bulky items. Contact borough for information or to purchase tags.

Leaf & Yard Waste (excluding grass): Yes. Leaves, grass clippings, branches less than 3" diameter, brush, plants, flowers, roots, shrubbery, wood chips, and saw dust. Check with borough for Yard Waste Bins, schedule, and materials collected. Yard waste bins are collected on specified weeks throughout the calendar years. Dates are also provided on borough utility bills. If a resident has extra yard waste that does not fit into a container, it is recommended that they bundle and tie branches together. The branch bundles can be no longer than 4 ft. and should be placed next to the container. For all other extra yard waste, residents may place these items in the brown biodegradable bags that may be purchased at most hardware stores. Please do not place the items in plastic bags as the waste dump sites for yard waste materials will not accept these items.

Christmas Trees: Yes. Live trees only, no decorations, and do not place in bags. Contact the borough for the location and schedule.

Recyclable Materials Collected

- Glass* food/beverage BOTTLES/JARS
- Aluminum
- Steel, and Tin CANS
- Plastic BOTTLES & JUGS
- Corrugated Cardboard, Magazines, Newspapers, Including Inserts
- Mixed Office Paper
- Junk Mail

Only bottles, jugs, cans, and clean paper are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not place materials in plastic bags and do not include any items not listed. Acceptable materials may periodically change so always follow the information provided from your hauler. Businesses must also recycle but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

*Glass is repurposed for use as an alternative daily cover.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Recycling can be confusing because what is accepted as recyclable may be different between hauling companies and communities. Recycling programs are driven by markets and vary from region to region and state to state. Newer residents that move to our community are often surprised by the differences.

"Wishcycling" and Contamination

Contamination occurs when trash/unacceptable materials are placed in your recycling bin. With wishcycling people mean well, but unintentionally hurt recycling programs by placing the wrong materials into their bins. Examples include plastic toys, food containers, tubing, or buckets. When placed in the recycling bin, these and similar items must be physically removed and then landfilled. It is estimated that up to 20% of the cost of recycling is used to deal with items that should have been placed in the trash. Items that are not listed as recyclable WILL NOT get recycled. This includes plastic bags.

Plastic is the most confusing material because it comes in a variety of forms and resins that are chemically different. People often think that because something is "plastic" that it is recyclable. This is not the case. The same holds true with the "recycling" symbol and number commonly found on plastic items. The purpose of the symbol and number is to indicate the resin type. It has nothing to do with recycling!

Instead, focus on the shape of item. When it comes to recycling, think "plastic bottles/jugs, metal cans, and clean paper." If you're holding a plastic item, consider if it is a bottle. For example, butter tubs, yogurt containers, and clam-shell/take-out food containers are plastic and usually have a recycling symbol and number on them. But - they are not a bottle/jug and belong in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out.

How to Prepare Your Recyclables

A simple rinse of food/beverage bottles and jugs is all that is needed. Cardboard should be flattened and mixed papers (magazines, junk mail, newspapers) can be placed in your bin loosely or in a brown paper bag. Do not put any materials in plastic bags. Plastic bags must be ripped open. And loose bags jam conveyor belts and gears. They are a significant cost to manage when they get into the system and will not get recycled at the recycling center. Many local grocers accept plastic bags for recycling.



Place potting soil in a small container. Moisten the soil well, but do not soak. Place seeds just below the surface of the soil, and cover the container with clear plastic, or insert it into a plastic bag, without letting plastic rest directly on the soil. This helps the soil retain moisture and heat. Place under a lamp for warmth, and keep the soil moist by "misting." As your sprouts appear and grow, remove plastic. Mist daily and keep sprouts warm until you are ready to transplant into your garden.

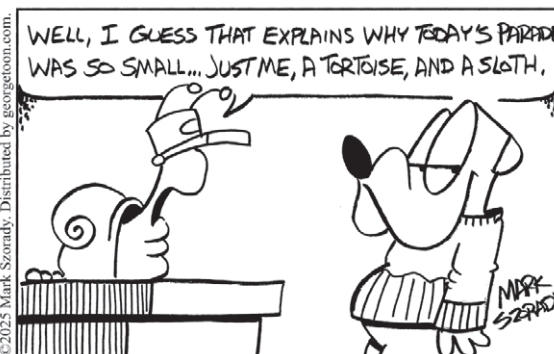

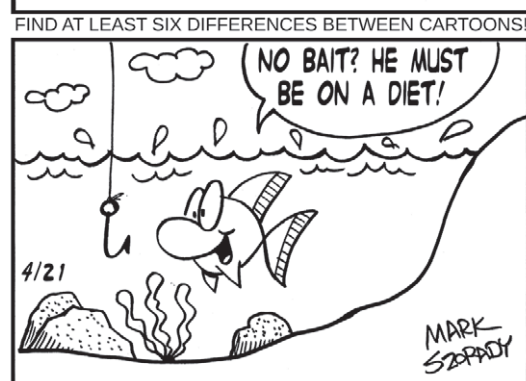
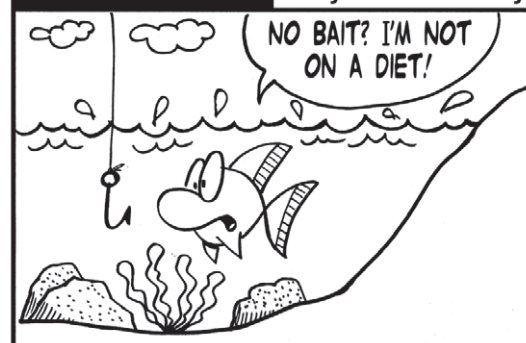

A new internet scam I'd thought I could identify an internet scam when it showed up, but there's a new one out now. It's slick and potentially dangerous if you fall for it. It's called the CAPTCHA scam. CAPTCHA stands for "completely automated public Turing test to tell computers and humans apart." They are those annoying interruptions when you're

trying to access a webpage. You typically have to click a box to prove you're not a robot. Then you have to type in the skewed letters on the screen and click all the parts of the streetlight, or car or bus or whatever the image is. All this before it allows you to go to the page you're trying to see. The newest scam is that these CAPTCHAs are spreading malware in your computer with every step. This is a sneaky scam because we've been lulled into complacency about those CAPTCHA verification tests, and we might tend to just click on it to get through it. Things are different now. If you

come across a CAPTCHA, check the address of the webpage by looking for "https" to be sure that little "s" is present. Here's how the scams work:

You might be instructed to download a file or to press certain keys. Or, after completing the first step, you might end up on a fake webpage that looks a lot like the one you were trying to get to.

Once you get through the steps, malware is installed on your computer without you knowing, and its job is to hunt for personal information on your machine.

If you suddenly get a CAPTCHA popping up when you don't expect it, back out of the page. Don't go there. Even if you're sure you're safe, don't download anything that a CAPTCHA steers you to. And as always, keep good virus protection on your computer.

EAR PAW'S CORNER: My dog "Happy" and I went hiking this weekend, and when we got back to the car, I did the usual check for bugs and burrs on his long coat. I was shocked to find 12 tiny ticks clinging to his fur. I brushed them off and found five more scurrying around my boot laces. These are baby ticks, right? Should I be worried about tick bites for both of us? – Karl M., Roanoke, Virginia

DEAR KARL: You should continue to be vigilant over the next few days, but don't worry too much – unless Happy shows signs of illness. Doing a "tick check" after each trip outdoors is important, and you did exactly what you needed to do.

Over the next few days, brush through Happy's coat frequently to dislodge any additional ticks. Newly hatched ticks are indeed tiny and hard to see. Run your hand through Happy's coat so that you can check his skin for visible bites or lodged ticks. If you notice a bull's-eye rash around an area, contact the veterinarian.

If you haven't treated your hiking boots or clothing with permethrin yet, now is the time to do so. Spray the treatment outside, away from Happy or any other animal, and do not let Happy near those clothes until they have dried completely. The permethrin will stay effective through a few washes.

To keep ticks out of the house, follow similar procedures to flea prevention. Give Happy a regular flea and tick preventative; vacuum and mop the house regularly, and terminate any ticks you find.

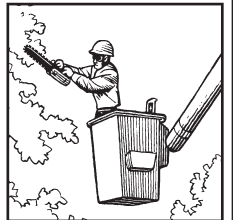

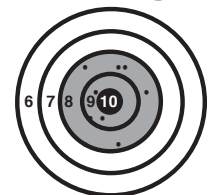
