



Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II Often Overlooked, Freshwater Mussels are Vital for Healthy PA Waters (Part 2 of 2)

When I was a child, I could have been labeled "curious," because even from an early age, I was extremely interested in exploring outdoors

and learning about animals. When an episode of Mutual of Omaha's "Wild Kingdom" or "The Undersea World of Jacques Cousteau" came on, I was probably glued to our TV set with my parents' or grandparents' blessing. Searching my memories, I can't recall a single nature program focusing on freshwater mussels and I also don't remember ever seeing a quality photograph or video of freshwater mussels "in action" during my undergraduate studies at Penn State.

All that comes to mind from our textbooks or lectures are "life cycle" diagrams of freshwater mussels. Well, my world was completely rocked during our May 16 visit to the PA Fish & Boat Commission's Aquatic Conservation Center (ACC) in Union City, when Species Recovery Biologist Scott Ray showed us detailed, high-quality underwater photographs and videos of many of the species of freshwater mussels inhabiting our PA waterways and their utterly fascinating reproductive behavior. Now, some actions to procreate are common across mussel species, but there are many details which are very species specific.

We are talking freshwater mussels here, so there are no courtship rituals or even the need for boy mussel to physically meet girl mussel to perpetuate the species. With typically hundreds or most likely thousands of mussels inhabiting a given stream, creek, or river; when it comes time to reproduce, the male mussels simply release their sperm into the flowing water and it is carried downstream to receptive female mussels. The female's fertilized eggs develop into glochidia, which are the mussel's ultra-tiny larval stage initially visible only under a microscope and measured in microns (only the size of ¼ of a grain of salt).

This is where things get really interesting and differ remarkably from species to species of freshwater mussels. The pregnant female mussels, sitting partially submerged in the streambed, riverbed, or lakebed have developed species-specific mantle lures across the top of their partially opened shells designed to attract select species of fish. If I hadn't seen the photos and videos myself, I wouldn't have believed it. Let's just say fishing lure manufacturers, who are designing realistic soft plastic lures to attract fisherfemale freshwater mussels. One species' mantle lure appears gray, is a few inches long, and undulates in flowing water. Coupled with a well-placed black dot that looks remarkably like an eye, this mantle lure deceives bass, to think it is a struggling minnow

men and fish, have nothing on these

fish, specifically bass, to think it is a struggling minnow on the bottom and an easy meal. When the fish bites the female mussel's mantle lure, she release her glochidia into the fish's mouth and they are transported to the fish's gills as the fish "breathes." The glochida become obligate parasites, attaching themselves to the fish's gills for 2 to 3-weeks as they mature and "hitchhike' themselves to new locations as the fish moves throughout the waterway. They eventually drop off to settle on the bottom and grow into adult mussels. The mussel larvae using the fish as a host apparently do not harm the fish in any way. Fish you catch may be transporting mussel larvae.

One species of mussel's mantle lure extends a few inches from their shell via a mucous string and it looks almost like a "Mister Twister" rubber lure dancing in the water to attract fish. Various mussel species have very different mantle lures designed to attract walleye, shad, brook trout, striped bass, eels, or darters as a host. Here in the Shenango River, we have a species of concern, the Pistol Grip mussel, whose mantle lure looks like rotting flesh to attract a very specific host, flathead catfish. (I'm looking forward to receiving a call from Scott Ray with an invitation to join him and his crew in gathering Pistol Grip mussels from the Shenango River sometime this summer for their propagation efforts.) At the ACC in Union City, they not only raise mussels, but they also keep the necessary host fish species on hand.

Recent PA mussel success stories include relocating 160,000 mussels from a prominent bed at Hunters Station a few miles below Tionesta, when they built the new US-62 Bridge across the Allegheny River several years ago. (Many were moved to the Clarion River.) Additionally, there are ongoing efforts to restock mussels in 30-miles of Greene County's Dunkard Creek after a major 2009 contamination event destroyed most aquatic life. (This year's mussel stocking is September 9.) Mussels are vital "biomarkers" indicating the health of our PA waterways. Please check out some YouTube videos on freshwater mussels for yourself. Since visiting the ACC in Union City, I have so much respect for these fascinating creatures, now I'm concerned about stepping on them when I wade!


