





Make and Bake a Rustic Tart With Kids Opportunities for families to experience life's simplest pleasures

abound during the summer days. We enjoy impromptu evening bike rides, free concerts in the park, or a jaunt in the country to pick berries.

On the return home, I choose juicy nectarines, peaches and plums at a roadside stand – a perfect combination with berries for preparing a delicious rustic fruit tart. Also called a galette, it is free-form and goes together easily, and the best part is that kids can get actively involved. Tell them they can be the “King and Queen of Tarts” as you show them how to stir, knead and roll out the pliable dough. Actually, it's perfect play for “royalty” of all ages! For a large family-style “Rustic Fruit Tart” to serve 6-8, you'll need:

DOUGH

- 1 1/2 cups unbleached all-purpose flour, plus 3-4 tablespoons for rolling out dough
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 10 tablespoons unsalted, cold butter cut into 1/2-inch chunks
- 3-4 tablespoons ice water

FILLING

- 1 cup berries (I like a combination of blueberries and raspberries or blackberries)
- 2 1/2 cups of peeled and thinly sliced fruit such as nectarines, peaches and plums
- 4-5 tablespoons sugar, plus 1 tablespoon for sprinkling
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon grated lemon zest (optional)
- Pinch of salt

Here's the fun: For dough, place flour and salt in a mixing bowl, and let kids stir together with clean fingers. Scatter butter chunks into flour mixture, and toss and rub between fingertips until butter is the size

of peas. Use a pastry blender, if you prefer.

Drizzle ice water over mixture and work it with your hands until all the flour is moistened and the dough comes together. Knead a few times on a flour-covered surface, shape into a disk, and wrap in plastic wrap. Refrigerate for 15-30 minutes.

Preheat oven to 400 F. Remove disk from refrigerator. If it is too hard to roll out, let stand in room temperature for 10 minutes. On a floured surface, roll out dough into a 12- to 14-inch circle. Transfer to a parchment-lined rimmed cookie sheet and chill about 15 minutes.

Toss together the fruit, sugar, flour, lemon juice, zest and salt. Remove dough from refrigerator. Mound fruit filling in the center of the dough, leaving a 2-inch border.

Fold border edge up and over fruit mixture in slightly overlapping pleats to form the sides of the tart, but leave the fruit center open 4-5 inches. Remember, it's rustic, so it doesn't need to look perfect! Brush dough with a little

water, sprinkle with sugar, and bake 50-55 minutes (or until golden brown).

Cool on rack, slide onto a serving plate, slice, and enjoy with vanilla ice cream!



Our Daily Bread

God Is in Control

The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised. Job 1:21
READ Job 1:6-12, 20-22

Carol couldn't understand why it was happening all at once. As if work wasn't bad enough, her daughter fractured her foot in school, and she herself came down with a severe infection. What did I do to deserve this? Carol wondered. All she could do was ask God for strength.

Job didn't know why calamity had hit him so hard either—pain and loss far greater than what Carol experienced. There's no indication he was aware of the cosmic battle for his soul. Satan wanted to test Job's faith, claiming he'd turn from God if he lost everything (Job 1:6-12). When disaster struck, Job's friends insisted he was being punished for his sins. That wasn't why, but he must have wondered, Why me? What he didn't know was that God had allowed it to happen.

Job's story offers a powerful lesson about suffering and about faith. We may try to discover the reason behind our pain, but perhaps there's a bigger story behind the scenes that we won't understand in our lifetime.

Like Job, we can hold on to what we do know: God is in full control. It's not an easy thing to say, but in the midst of his pain, Job kept looking to God and trusting in His sovereignty: "The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised" (v. 21). May we too keep trusting in God no matter what happens—and even when we don't understand. By Leslie Koh

Trash Talk, Turf Wars, and Cat Calls It's the Norm with the Birds



The United States recently celebrated Flag Day on Sat., June 14, and it was also the U.S. Army's official birthday. This year was very special, since

the Army proudly celebrated 250-years going back to 1775. What you may not know is some U.S. Army customs and practices pre-date the Army's official organization. One of those practices is "Stand To," a term even some soldiers may not be familiar with, unless they were in the Infantry or directly supported the Infantry, as was my case being an Artilleryman.

"Stand To" goes back to the 1750's and the French & Indian War. With the American Colonists sided with the British in that conflict, it was a common French & Indian tactic to attack one-hour before sunrise. Thus, having the element of surprise and ever increasing daylight as the attack progressed. "Stand To" was the tactical necessity to have every soldier awake, dressed (boots on), and in their fighting positions one hour before sunrise in the event a surprise attack came. This is before personal hygiene and breakfast is served. Many soldiers only experience "Stand To" in Basic Training, unless they are in Combat Arms. For almost 300-years, at least some of the U.S. Army has been practicing "Stand To" to remain vigilant.

I am blessed with the capacity to operate on very little sleep. That coincides with an ability to fall asleep within 2-minutes of closing my eyes. So, even if a typical night's shut-eye was only 4.5-hours, I was able to productively go for weeks with limited sleep. One of my tricks for being ready for "Stand To" out in the field, "up and at 'em" well over an hour before sunrise was to use the first birds' songs as a natural alarm clock. If you sleep with the windows open or work in a profession that requires an early start before daylight, especially during the summer heat, such as construction, farming, or work in a service industry where you have to be there for the early risers; you're familiar with how the birds get started singing, chirping, and announcing their presence well before there is any hint of daylight on the Eastern horizon.

While bird songs are delightful to listen to, tremendously varied, and a great means of identifying an often unseen source, there is more going on than meets the ear. While it may sound like a particular bird is just joyously announc-

ing their presence to the world for everyone to hear, there is definitely directed communication involved in this early morning chatter and in the calls/songs you hear throughout the day.

I'll use the American Robin as an example, since it is the most common

member of the Thrush Family and has adapted very well to living amongst human habitation. Most individuals are aware of its distinct black/brown coloration with an orange-red breast. (Male robins have darker black heads with brighter breast feathers, while females have lighter brown heads with more subdued breast feathers.) Like many avian species, the males typically arrive several days or even a few weeks before the females. This is when the competition for breeding territories is fierce. Many of the bird calls you hear from robins and other species are announcements of their staked-out territories. This is when they get into "trash talk" with other members of their species, announcing "this is mine" and "there's going to be a fight, if you come into my space." If you think back, you can probably recall a battle or two over the past few months as the male robins got into "turf wars," fighting for territory as they seek productive feeding grounds and choice nesting sites. It's interesting how most bird conflicts are primarily within their own species and the home territories of many different species will overlap, since they often use very diverse nesting sites (ground, bush, or trees at various heights) and rely on different food sources (insects, seeds, nectar, etc.).

Once the males have established their territories, that's when the "cat calls" start. Each male is trying his best to attract a mate. "Hey, baby come over here and see what kind of living and feeding options my place can offer for raising a family!" "I'm the one you want to be with to perpetuate our species!" I know there are ornithologists who have made it their life's work studying bird calls, but if they can ever create an App that could listen to a bird's call and then give us an accurate translation, I think we would be shocked by how salty or sultry the birds are talking to each other in our midst. We would get an earful and possibly blush, but "trash talk," "turf wars," and "cat calls" are a way of life for the birds all around us.

Recently, I watched a feisty little ruby-throated hummingbird defend "his nectar feeder" from other hummingbirds (even though there was an abundance of nectar) and for the first time, I watched two crows seriously "throw down" with chest bumps, wing thrashings, and aggressive clawing. The birds around us are amazing and their calls/behavior warrant our attention!





Q: I have two newspapers that I found in a relative's historical storage box containing research paper work

tracing their lineage. One is "The Rebel," dated August 9, 1862. The other is "The Daily Citizen" (first edition?) dated July 2, 1863. It is printed on a green floral designed wallpaper. How do I tell if they are authentic?

A: Both of your newspapers have famously been copied and reprinted since the 19th century. The earliest copies were made as souvenirs for G.A.R. reunions. Later ones were made to observe the 50th and 100th anniversaries of the Civil War. "The Daily Citizen" was published by J.M. Swords in Vicksburg, Mississippi. During the Civil War, many publishers in the South ran out of newsprint, so Swords printed issues of "The Daily Citizen" on wallpaper. The July 2, 1863, edition has a note from the Union forces that captured Vicksburg, declaring "This is the last wall-paper edition" and "It will be valuable hereafter as a curiosity." It is extremely unlikely that your copies are originals. The Library of Congress has online guides to antique newspapers (<https://guides.loc.gov/noteworthy-newspaper-issues>), including these issues. They list ways to recognize originals (there are certain clues in the size, proportions and certain spellings) and additional resources. ©2025 King Features Synd., Inc.

What is "Precycling"?

Precycling is the practice of reducing the amount of your trash and recyclables by taking action before you buy something.

Examples of precycling are: Limiting purchases to things that you need. Delaying purchases that aren't urgently needed. Buying in bulk to avoid extra packaging.

Why Does This Matter?

Much of what we throw away or recycle can be avoided. In addition to filling up landfills, some items can be hazardous to us and our environment.

What Can I do?

Precycling is easy! Here are some easy suggestions to get you started.

Plastic Bags - Bring reusable shopping bags to the stores.

Individually Wrapped Products - Buy products in bulk with little to no packaging.

Coffee Filters - Use reusable coffee filters instead of single use paper ones.

Coffee Shop Cup - Take your own reusable cup or travel mug.

Disposable Eating Utensils - Opt for reusable plates, take-out containers, or silverware.

Paper or Plastic Lunch Bag - Take a lunch box or reusable bag.

Take-out Food - Bring reusable containers.

Single Use Plastic Water Bottles - Use refillable bottles.

Paper Towels - Use cloth towels.

Photocopies - Print double sided to save paper.

Notebooks - Buy paper that has post-consumer recycled content.

Household Batteries - Buy rechargeable batteries and a charger or use solar powered substitutes.

Recycle chargeable batteries instead of discarding.

Appliance, Tools and Equipment - Repair, share, and lend things such as equipment and tools.

Replacement products - Spend a little more to buy durable goods that will last longer and save money over time.

Home improvement supplies - When you have left over supplies, give them to a friend or donate them to Habitat for Humanity.

Straws - Use metal or hard plastic reusable straws.







I'll bet you've never heard of this one before! My cousin has a female dog who has never been spayed. So she routinely will go into heat. Well, a few months ago, she started behaving funny. She didn't want to eat, she started pacing the house and then would flop down and not want to go outside, for walks or anything. Even though she wasn't eating much, she put on weight and her mammarys started to swell. She also started "guarding" her toys and acting aggressive if anyone tried to reach for them. I told my cousin, maybe she's pregnant, but he insisted that she had never been around a male dog or gone unsupervised outside.



He took her to the vet because he thought she was ill. Would you believe, the vet diagnosed her with a "phantom" pregnancy? She had all the signs of being pregnant but there were no puppies. The vet gave her medication for a few weeks, and eventually she got back to her old self. What do you think about that? - Terry P. in Albany, New York ©2025 King Features Synd., Inc.

DEAR TERRY: I have heard of this before! In unspayed females, pseudo-pregnancy, or "phantom pregnancy," can happen after a heat cycle. It's uncomfortable for the dog and concerning for the owner.

Treatment includes confirming the absence of a pregnancy, followed by medication to reduce anxiety and stop milk production. Hormone therapy is sometimes needed. The best way to stop phantom pregnancy from happening again is to spay the dog after all symptoms have subsided, and it's highly recommended. Spaying will help your cousin's dog be far more comfortable - she won't go through heat cycles any longer - and have a healthier, longer lifespan, too.
